

Field Notes of the Eastern boundary line of Collin County and part of the Western boundary line of Hunt County

Magnetic meridian 10° East of North
Verner of Compass set 9° 20' west of magnetic meridian

Beginning at the 85th mile post in the boundary line of Tarrant Land District and the 25th mile post in the South boundary line thereof as run by Orr in the month of April & May 1850


