

Report of Survey of Co. line between
Comanche and Brown Counties.

The State of Texas (^{variation. 9° 30' E.}
County of Comanche) The Hon. Commissioners
Court of Comanche and Brown Counties.
In obedience to an order passed by the
Commissioners of Comanche County at their
Aug. term 1891 and the Commissioners
of Brown County at their November
term 1891, ordering us to establish
the line between Comanche and
Brown Counties, We proceeded to
establish said line as follows:
After getting all the information we
could, we established the N.W. Corner
of Comanche and the N.E. Corner of
Brown Counties on Sec. No. 11
eleven surveyed for the Buffalo
Bayou and Brazos Colorado
Rail Road Company 641 varas
South and 476 varas S 60° W from
the N.E. Corner of said section No
11 at which point we set a rock
in the ground marked NE Cor. B.C.
On the Brown County side and
N.W. Cor. C.C. on the Comanche
County side from which a post
Oak marked N.W. C.C. to N 62° 30'
E 9 varas another Post Oak aka
N.E. Cor. B.C. to S 4° W 18 varas from
this point we ran S 30° E at 659
vs we crossed the East line
Sec. No 11- 299 vs north of S E Cor.
of same at 1168 vs crossed the
South line of Sec. No 30, at
1920 vs set 1st mile rock in the
edge of Rankins field thence S 30

E at 1680 vs crossed south line of sec,
 31 and north line of sec. No. 32 at
 1900 vs 2nd mile in B.C. Kitchens
 field. Thence S 30° E at 1025 crossed
 the east line of No 32 and west
 line of sec. No 1. surveyed for the
 East Texas Railway Company
 20 vs south of the division corner
 of said sec. No. 1 at 1900 vs set the
 3rd mile stone at the base of a
 mountain. Thence S 30° E at 540
 vs crossed the Comanche and
 rising star road at 680 vs crossed
 the north line of the Jesse Dickinson
 survey at 800 vs crossed the
 East Point of Mountain at 1900
 vs set the 4th mile stone. Thence
 30° E at 246 vs crossed Sipe Springs
 and Brownwood road at 820 vs
 base of Mtn, 940 vs top of Mtn, at
 1020 vs crossed ravine at 1160 vs
 top of Mountain at 1760 vs base
 of Mountain at 1900 vs set the 5th
 mile stone in Cove of Mountain
 Thence S 30° E at 260 vs base of moun-
 tain at 420 vs top of said mountain
 580 vs brink of Mountain on south
 side at 770 vs base of Mountain
 and east line of said Jesse Dickinson survey
 and west line of A. Sullivan survey
 at 1900 vs set the 6th mile stone. Thence S 30°
 E at 1375 vs crossed the south line of said
 Sullivan survey and 1269 vs East
 of the S.W. corner of said Sullivan survey
 and the north line of sur. No 1.
 surveyed for the Houston Tap and
 Brazoria R.R. Co 931 vs West of
 N.E. Cor of said No 1. at 1450
 v. crossed South Coffman

Creek (Course East) at 1900 vs set
The 7th mile stone a double post oak
mkd C. C. L. by S E 7²/₅ vs another
pd mkd B. C. L. about S 60° W 13²/₅ vs
thence S 30° E at 1112 vs Branch Course
East at 1439 vs cross the west line
of W. J. Mitchell No. 6 and 941 vs North
of the SW corner of said Mitchell and
369 vs South of the NE corner of
sec No 2 at 1900 vs set the 8th mile
stone on the South side of a prairie
slope near timber thence S 30° E at
230 vs Branch Course East at 1900
vs set the 9th mile stone on a live
Oak ridge thence S 30° E at 113
Walnut Creek at 220 come
out of said creek at 325 vs
crossed the North line of W. J.
Mitchell No. 4, 5, 19 vs East of
NW corner of same at 1400
vs base of mountain at 1900
vs set the 10th mile stone on East
side of said mountain near a
ravine thence S 30° E at 60 vs crossed
ravine at 260 vs top of mountain
480 vs cross ravine 600 top of mountain
800 base of mountain at 1360 vs
Patridge creek 1900 vs set the 11th mile
stone at base of mountain thence
S 30° E at 1600 brink of mountain
515 vs foot of mountain on South
side and North line of sec No 14
made for East Texas R. R. Co. at
1900 vs set the 12 mile stone
on the North side of a post oak
ridge near the head of a ravine

Thence S 30° E. at 150 vs branch Course
 S E 290 vs same branch at 466 vs
 Crossed South line of Sec No 14 at
 500 vs same branch Course East
 560 vs another Branch at 1553
 vs Creek Course East at 1900
 vs set the 13th mile rock on
 the north slope of a small moun-
 tain thence S 30° E 69 vs top of said
 mountain 770 vs branch Course
 East at 1640 vs crossed a deep
 ravine in past oak timber
 1900 vs set the 14 mile stone in
 a small prairie on the East side
 of slope between past oak timber
 and track thence S 30' E. at 235-
 vs crossed creek Course North
 at 547 vs another prong of same
 Creek at 1162 crossed fence on
 North line survey No 43. Comanche
 County School Land at 1266 crossed
 the East line of said sur No 43 at
 1880 vs another prong of said creek
 at 1900 vs set the 15th mile stone on
 the East bank said creek. Thence
 S 30° E. at 100 vs branch Course North
 863 vs crossed fence on North line
 of survey No 42 Comanche County
 School land at 1900 vs set the 16th
 mile stone about 100 vs East of
 Wilsons house, thence S 30° E.
 at 95 vs crossed the west line
 of subd, No 44 belonging to E. J.
 Whitt Est. and 15 vs South of S. E.
 corner of subd. No 46 belonging
 to said Wilson 1187 vs crossed
 the Comanche and Coleman
 road and South line said
 4 at 1900 vs set the 17th mile

Stone in a mesquite flat in Harb's pas-
 ture on Subd. No 43 About 100 vs
 N.W. of a tank - thence S 30° E. at
 80 vs crossed East line of subd.
 No 43, at 120 vs crossed tank in
 Yalloways pasture at 354 vs
 grave yard. thence at 394 vs crossed
 the South line of subd No 33. ^{and}
 N. line of subd, No 34 and 255
 vs East of the S.W. Corner of
 subd No 33, and N.W. Cor subd
 No 34 at 1480 vs crossed tank
 in Thompson's pasture at 1900
 vs set the 18th mile stone in J.B.
 Thompson's pasture on subd,
 No 35. thence S 30° E. at 45 vs
 crossed East line subd, No 35-
 and west line of subd, No 26 be-
 longing to Mrs. Smith at 692 vs
 crossed South line of No, 26 ^{and}
 north line of No 25 - belonging
 to J.B. Dabney and 333 vs. East
 of the S.W. Corner of No 26 and
 N.W. Cor No 25 - at 861 crossed
 the Ft. W. & R. G. R.R. at 1080 vs crossed
 prong of Blanket Creek Course West
 at 1802 vs crossed south line
 No 25 - 49 vs West of the S.W. Corner
 of said No 25 at 1900 vs set the
 19th mile stone on the East line
 of subd. No 24. and West line of
 subd. No 22 and 84 vs South of
 the N E Corner of No 24 and N W
 Corner of No 22 - and North
 line of subd, No 23 - belonging
 to D. Hammond at 1413 vs crossed

South line of Subd. No 23. and South
 line No 42 Comanche County
 School land and 2273 vs West
 of S.E. Corner of said 42 at 1900 vs
 set the 20th mile stone in the Bartlett's
 pasture thence South 30° E. at 1642
 vs crossed South line of NW 1/4 Sec
 No 26 surveyed by the H. T. & B. R. R.
 Co 1900 vs set the 21st mile rock
 in pasture on Sec. 26 thence
 S 30° E. at 853 vs cross South line
 of Sec. 26 and North line of 25-
 at 1900 vs set the 22nd mile
 stone on rocky hill in old
 Barnes pasture thence S 30° E. at
 627 vs crossed the East line of Sec
 No 25 and 45-2 vs North of S.E. Cor-
 ner of same at 115-2 vs cross
 South line Sec. No 24 and
 North line of Sec. 27 at 1900 vs
 set the 23 mile stone on East
 side of slope in Spanish brush
 a double Spanish Oak by the stone
 marked X and B thence S 30° E
 at 935 crossed the old Mercer
 Gap road and the North line
 of the pro. Bollinger Survey No 315
 and 1702 vs West of the N.E. Corner
 of said Bollinger sur at 1260
 vs prong of Dry Blanket Course
 at 1355 West string of Couch
 pasture fence at 1900 vs
 set 24th mile stone on P.O.
 marked B.C.L 24 M another
 marked C.C.L 24 M thence S 30 East
 at 1240 vs crossed Dry Blanket or
 at 19 vs set the 25th mile stone
 on South side of W.C. Barnes
 pasture fence and about 20 vs

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West of Chappel Hill School house
thence S 30° E. at 448 vs branch 568
vs cross the East line said
Bollinger Survey 595 vs South of
the NW Corner of sec, No 43 E 7 R R
Co at 1000 vs top of Mountain
1600 vs cross the Comanche and
Zephyr road at 1900 vs set the
26 mile stone at the foot of a
small mountain on the South
side - thence South 30° E. at 500
vs branch at North base of
mountain about 100 vs East
of Bynnes house at 700 vs
top of small mountain 1900
vs to the 27th mile in W. Wilk
field no stone at this point
thence S 30° E at 600 vs base
of mountain 800 vs top of
mountain at 1900 vs 28th
stone in a Spanish Oak flat, thence
S 30° E. at 1268 vs crossed the West
line of the Walter Hinkley survey
878 vs South of NW corner of same
and 72 vs North of the S.E. corner
of the J. E. Shannon survey (presumption)
at 1900 vs set the 29th mile stone in
Allens pasture in a small prairie
thence S 30° E. at 1125 - crossed the South
line of said Hinkley and the North
line of the J. H. Cox presumption sur
at 1892 vs to the Mills county line in
Gas Hill field on said Cox survey at
said point we established the S E
corner of Brown County and S W
corner of Comanche County
by setting a rock in the ground
marking S.E. Cor. B.C. and S W
Cor. C.C. from which said

rock the S E Corner of said T. H. Cot Survey to S 85° 30' E 369 2/5 rods. The mile stones just at the end of each mile was marked this B.C.L. with the number of miles on the Brown County side and marked this on the Comanche County side C.C.L. with the number of miles. The line trees we marked with a blaze and hack above and below on side next to the line given under our hands at the town of Comanche this 10th day of February 1892.

 adopted and ordered recorded
 And said line as run and
 established is hereby adopted
 recognized and established
 as the County line between
 Brown and Comanche Counties.

 this the 11th day of Feb. 1892.
