13 compliance with the order of
14 said Court on the Low in the
15 premises.

16 It is therefore ordered adjudged
17 and decreed by this Court that
18 the County Surveyor of said
19 Comanche County do it: - J. L.
20 Halman he and he is hereby
21 ordered to act as surveyor and
22 it is further ordered adjudged and
23 decreed by the Court, that said
24 Halman meet the County surveyor of
25 Mills County at 12 o'clock noon
26 on the supposed line of Mills & Com-
27 anche Counties; Beginning where
28 the Mills County line crosses the old
29 Brown and Comanche County line
30 on the 6th day of December A.D. 1887
31 there and there Establish the line
32 legally between the County of Mills & Comanche
"Counties"
