2 Comanche County } Commissioners Court
3 of Comanche County Texas, At the
4 February Term 1894 of the Commissioners
5 Court of said County, I, F. L. Busey
6 was appointed to meet the County
7 Surveyor of Mills County at
8 the house of O. N. McDermott, on the
9 12 day of March 1894, for the purpose
10 of legally establishing the line
11 between the Counties of Comanche
12 and Mills. By Mutual agreement
13 between said Surveyor of Mills County
14 and myself it was agreed that
15 we should meet at the S.W. Corner
16 of Comanche County on the aforesaid
17 date, this we did and there
18 and there proceeded to run said
19 line there having previously been
20 run three lines between Comanche
21 and Brown County, we selected
22 the middle line as being in our judg-
23 ment the most nearly correct and as
24 being the one most generally
25 recognized; Beginning at the S.W.
26 Corner of Comanche County which
27 bears West 440 vrs and North 17 vrs
28 from the S.E. Corner of pre emp. survey
29 No 343 in the name of T. N. Cox
30 and from which S.W. cor. a spl.
31 oak tree used B. bears N. 84° W.
32 40 vrs do. brs S. 48° W 50 vrs used M

1 Thence N. 82° E. at 444 vs intersect the
 2 East line of said T. N. Cox 79 vs North from
 3 its S. E. Cor at 960 vs the 27th mile
 4 rock. Thence N 82° E. 1900 vs
 5 to rock for 28th mile. Thence North
 6 82° at 1528 vs intersect the
 7 East line of survey no 303 in the name of
 8 Jos George. 21 vs South from his N.E.
 9 Corner at 1900 vs rock for the 29th mile. Thence
 10 N. 82° E. at 130 vs intersect the
 11 South line of sec. no 23. Blk II
 12 made for V.C.T. RR. Company and

 21 of surveys and to make his
 22 report on same according to
 23 law.
