

1 It is ordered by the Court that  
2 the report of J. A. Holman County  
3 Surveyor, Be adopted and the  
4 same is in all things approved  
5 and ordered of Record and the  
6 same is as follows to wit;  
7 To the Honorable Commissioners Court of Comanche  
8 County Texas In accordance with an order  
9 issued at the November Term of Court direct-  
10 ing J. A. Holman, as surveyor and  
11 in connection with the surveyor of  
12 Mills County to legally lay out and  
13 mark the lines between the Counties of  
14 Mills and Comanche and having com-  
15 pleted as aforesaid directed by to submit  
16 the following report and field notes of work  
17 There being three lines previously run  
18 and marked between the Counties of Brown  
19 and Comanche and the Middle line of the  
20 three being generally recognized as most  
21 correct and the same having been agreed  
22 upon between myself and the surveyor  
23 of Mills County and Brown County.  
24 We established the S.W. Corner for Comanche  
25 County by setting a stone in the ground which  
26 bears E. 44° vs and S. 17° vs from the  
27 S.W. Corner of Preemption Survey No 343  
28 in name of T. H. Cox also a Spanish oak  
29 Tree br N 84° W. 40 vs marked B another Spanish  
30 oak br S 48° W. 50 vs. marked M.  
31 Thence N 82° East 1960 vs a stone  
32 set in the ground marked for the 27<sup>th</sup>

Number 51991  
(Comanche Co. Bdry. Line # 2c)

1 Mile Rock, Thence N. 82° East 1900  
2 vs the 28<sup>th</sup> Mile Rock, Thence N 82°

 18 Cross surveyor line of Comanche  
 19 County here we establish the Cor.  
 20 of Comanche County which is  
 21 also a Corner of Mills County and  
 22 Hamilton Counties which Corner  
 23 bears N. 30 E. 9 1/2 miles from the  
 24 west line of Comanche County
