Letter of Surveyor

All notes line between Erath & Comanche
County Established by J. H. Huffman
Surveyor of Erath co, & R. Hill Surveyor
Comanche County on 21st day May 1848.
found all corner of Hamilton
County, which is S W cor. of Erath co,
11 miles S 60 W from S W cor Bosque
County. (all bearings all right) this
cor is in the J. B. Bonham Sur. We then
ran S 30 W, passed 220 vs S 71 W
from S. E. cor Jno. W. Bonhill Survey
distance to this line of the Bonhill
from the cor is 2370 vs, at 9250 vs
made cor in W. H. Delliana Sur. Thence
S 60 W 5 miles to cor in the S W
quarter of Sec No 26 E T R Co
Surveyed for H. Barber this cor is 415 vs
S 30 E and 112 vs S 60 E from the
S W cor of this quarter (in running
this line we passed 1478 vs S 19 W from
S W cor of Delliana distance from
cor to the west line Delliana is 1070 vs
also passed 300 vs S 30 E from S W
cor Jas Brewer Cor. Sur.) Thence
S 30 W passed 1320 vs S 71 E from
S W corner of Wm Mc Lelland Sur.
+ 340 vs S 71 W from S. E. cor of R. D
Ross Cor. Sur, 290 vs S 71 W from the
S W cor C. H. Jasper Sur, connected with

Dear Sir, I thus hand you full notes of the line of Grant Comanche Counties, which is duly recorded here as the law requires, we were particular in running this line & establishing it as you see by giving connections along the line with different surveys, I run the line June 1877, between Brown & Comanche & returned full notes to our County Court which are also of record, this line passes about 100 or so from the N.W. Cor of Survey to 125 Hays County School Land, I did not connect the N.W. Cor of Comanche to any known corner of surveys, but in drawing the line you can establish on the map by the connection with H. Co School Land, it will cut in Sec No 14 B.D. B C R Co, near N line to 11.
