

To Hon. G. H. Garland

County Judge of Concho Co.

Dear Sir:

In Compliance with an order of the Hon Commissioners Court of Concho County directing me to establish the N.E. Corner of Concho County, I have the honor to make the following report, with the accompanying Sketch. On account of the broken and ruggedness of the Country along the river, and the additional distance to run by following the Meanderings of the river, I took the nearest Course, I could find at the same time selecting the best ground to run over, as you will see by accompanying Sketch. The distance already run from the S.E. Corner of Concho Co to the Colorado river was 27 Miles and 1060 vrs. which would leave ~~for~~ 5 Miles & 840 vrs. further North to go.

Beginning at a stone on the South bank of the Colorado river on which is marked, 102. m. 1060 vs. NW Co N.E. Co 27 M. & 1060 vs. Concho Co and from which a Pecan 14 in brs S. 40 1/2 W 28 vs. Another Pecan 30 in dia brs N 14 W 3 1/2 vs. (This point is 27 miles & 1060 vs North from the S.E. Corner of Concho Co)

Thence South ³³⁵⁰ 3350 vrs.

" S 45 W 1390 " (S 982. N. 982)

" West 4040 "

" N. 45 W. 9400 " (N 6645 W 6645)

" North 5600 "

" West 530 "

" North 350 " South side of Colorado river where road goes down the bluff

Thence North 248 vrs to top of bluff on North side of river

Thence North 196 vrs,

Thence West 309 vs to bank of Colorado river, where West line of Coleman Co joins the river, a stone bet into the ground made for SW Cor of Coleman Co. from which a Pecan 12 brs N 48 W 35 vs another Pecan 16 in brs S 29 E 20 vs, bearings marked C & R C L, 35.

Thence North 482 vrs a stone let into the ground marked C. & R. C. L.

Thence North 1086 vrs, a stone mound, on stone marked NE. Cor CONCHO, Co.

Thence West 300 vs to bank Colorado river, a hackberry 8 in dia, hacked on four sides with four hammers, and from which the junction of Concho & Colorado rivers bears South 590 & West 70 vrs, and an old S. W. said to be made for N. line of Concho Co brs N. 396 & W 86 vrs.
