Yours of July 5<sup>th</sup> in regard to Menard & Concho Co Line to hand.  
Beg to state that I perfectly agree with Mr. Schuchard  
in all his statements.

In regard to the call for the N.E. corner of the Mary Williams  
survey it is bound to be a Clerical error, for on my original  
report, which I have before me now, & was carefully comp-  
ared with Mr. Schuchard's, we call for the N.E. cor of this  
survey, commencing at the 2. mile stone. "Hence W. at  
1561 varas, the N.E. cor. of Jane Williams survey no. 104 (  
a Pt M'd. from which a L0. 12. N. 27 3/4 W. 82. varas; L0. 62. N. 61. W.  
39 3/4. varas) bears S. 652. varas."

In regard to the variation, the line was run by my instrument  
& as my report shows on a variation of "g° 20' E. being  
identical with the West line of McCulloch Co." & this  
variation on my instrument corresponded to Mr. Schuchard  
set at g° 35'.

I see that Land Office has accepted your west line; Now if they  
doubt the correctness of the North line, How can they possibly  
accept the west line which was based on the North line
