the Leon 8 miles & 400 varras crossed First Creek
9 miles and 1240 varras crossed Owl ^{Creek} at 14 miles
and 20 varras crossed Cow house ^{Creek} at 19 miles 1600
varras crossed the Military Road at 22 miles
1700 varras crossed the head of South Noland creek
at 26 miles 320 varras crossed Bee creek a branch of
Cowhouse creek ^{1300 varras} 30 miles a branch of the Sanpasses
at 30 miles 1770 varras another branch 31 miles
1790 varras a small branch at 32 miles a
pile of Rocks for the SW corner of Coryell
County from which a Live Oak bar N 41
E 55 varras marked H another MKD & bar
N 12 E 50 varras also a Sugar Loaf mount
bars N 38 W
