herein on the 19th day of July 1884, was duly
examined and considered, and the same
are approved, and the Clerk of this Court
is ordered to record the report and map
upon the minutes of this Court. And he is
further ordered to make a true and certified
Copy of the report and map, and forward
the same in a registered package to the Commis-
sioner of the General Land Office at Austin
at as early a day as the business of his
office will permit, to the end that the
Comptroller of the State may be notified
and the Abstract of titles corrected as
set out in said report, in order

The undersigned was appointed by order of the Hon. County Commissioners Court of Do Witt County at the May Term 1884, Special County Surveyor to assist C. O. Carstens, the County Surveyor of Goliad County to survey and mark out the county line between Goliad and Do Witt Counties, he have to report to your Hon. Body, the undersigned met the said C. O. Carstens, Surveyor of Goliad County and W. J. Soale, Surveyor of Tharmer County at the date (17th May 1884) and place designated in the above named order.

Beginning at a stake on the St. Gonzales District line on the south west side of the main Colecto, midway between two Live Oaks near together and about 100 varas from said Colecto, one of the Live Oaks 30 inch. in diam. marked D.W. bears S. $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 5 varas, and a dead Live Oak marked \equiv bears N. $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 5 varas, old bearing trees.

Thence S. 51° W. with the old marked line at $1900\frac{8}{10}$ varas set a post in mound for the first mile, from which a Live Oak 3 feet in diam. marked A bears N. $13\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 45 varas, at $3801\frac{4}{10}$ varas set a post for the second mile, from which a Post Oak 16 inch. in diam. marked B bears S. 51° W. 158 varas, at $4599\frac{6}{10}$ varas the south east line of the Jose Santos League and

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Labor, at $5401\frac{6}{10}$ varas middle of Hosier Crook, ^{runs} ~~course~~ south east, at $5702\frac{4}{10}$ varas, set a post in mound for the third mile, from which a Live Oak marked C bears S. 85° W. 27 varas, at $7603\frac{2}{10}$ varas set a post in mound for the fourth mile, from which a Post Oak 14 inch. in diam. marked D bears N. 59° E 11 varas and another 12 inch in diam. marked X bears S. 62° W. 19 varas, at $8203\frac{2}{10}$ varas road from Yorktown to Middletown, at $9270\frac{2}{10}$ intersects the east line of H. Poore preemption survey and south $44\frac{3}{4}$ varas of the north east corner of said preemption survey, at 9504 varas set a post in mound for the fifth mile, from which a Post Oak 18 inch in diam. marked E bears S. 20° W. 14 varas, at 10,304 varas the middle of the 18 miles Colets, runs south east, at 10,395 varas intersected the south line of the Guadalupe Colloge survey and west 81 varas of the south east corner of said survey, at $11,404\frac{8}{10}$ varas set a post in mound for the sixth mile, from which a Live Oak 20 inch. in diam. marked E bears S. $39\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W. $12\frac{1}{4}$ varas, at $12,575\frac{8}{10}$ varas intersected the west line of the W^m Greyman survey and S. 1° E. 35 varas from the north east corner of W. S. Hughes 320 acres of land survey, at $13,305\frac{6}{10}$ varas set a post in mound for the seventh mile, from which a Post Oak 18 inch. in diam. marked C. bears N. 80° E. $8\frac{1}{2}$ varas, at $15,128\frac{6}{10}$ varas the middle of the Manahilla and about 200 varas below the mouth of Panther Crook, at $15,206\frac{4}{10}$ varas, set a post in mound for the eighth mile, from which a large forked Live Oak marked H. bears S. $82\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. $104\frac{1}{2}$ varas, at $17,107\frac{2}{10}$ varas set a post in mound for the ninth mile, from which a Live Oak 14 inch. in diam. marked I. bears S. 31° E. $27\frac{1}{4}$ varas, at 19,008 varas set a post in mound for the tenth mile, from which a Live Oak 16 inch. in diam.

marked J. bears N. 78 1/2° E. 34 1/2 varas, at 19,640 varas bears N. 41° W. 400 varas the east corner of the A. Lazo survey, at 20,908 8/10 varas set a post in mound for the eleventh mile from which a Musqt. 12 inch. in diam. marked K bears S. 33° E. 65 1/2 varas, at 22,078 3/10 varas Elm Creek, at 22,809 6/10 varas set a post in mound for the twelfth mile, from which a Musqt. marked L. bears S. 33° E. 38 vrs at 24,710 4/10 varas set a post in mound for the thirteenth mile, from which a Musqt. marked M bears S 51° W. 327. varas, at 24,996 4/10 varas the middle of the Cabeza and S. 14° E. 245 varas from the south corner of the A. Lazo and the north west corner of the V. Ramos surveys, at 26,611 2/10 varas set a post for the fourteenth mile, from which a Musqt. marked N. bears N. 30° W. 90. vrs at 28,169 2/10 varas the old corner of Goliad & De Witt Counties, most of the old bearings remains visible.

J. C. G. Hartmann appointed and qualified Special County Surveyor to survey the boundary lines of De Witt County, do hereby certify, that the foregoing survey was made in conjunction with the surveyors from Goliad & Karnes Counties and is a resurvey of the line ran and reported in August 1848 by the surveyors from Goliad and De Witt Counties in accordance with, An Act of the Legislature of the State of Texas, to define more correctly the boundaries of De Witt Co approved Feby 26 1848. also certify, that I have examined the foregoing field notes and find them correct and in conformity with my field book.

The accompanying plat showing the different surveys on both sides of the line between De Witt and Goliad Counties, has been careful drawn from my personal

knowledge, ^{of said surveys} having heretofore the surveys adjoining said ⁴ line, resurveyed, and further state: that the abstract of titles for Do Witt Co are to contain 287 acres of land of the survey of Alfred R. Allee ass^{ee} of the consolidated El Paso Irrig^g Manu^{fact}. Co; ^{survey} 67 acres of land of the S. Sherman survey and 43 acres of land of the W. C. Howard survey; which are at present assigned to Goliad Co.

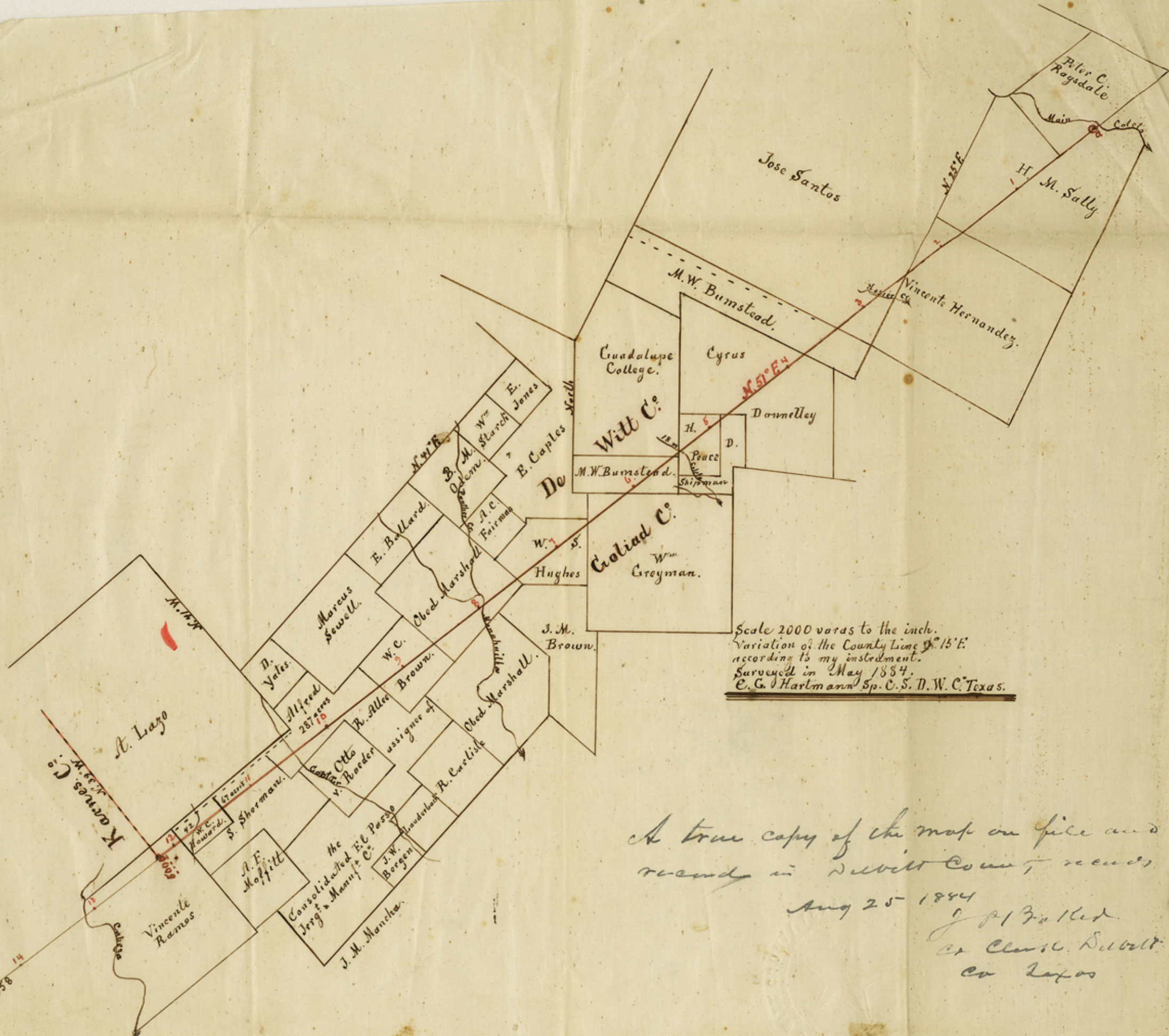
