January 10<sup>th</sup> 1882

To The Hon County Court of Dimmit  
County I would Respectfully Represent  
to your Honorable body that I have  
run the County lines of Dimmit County  
as follows Beginning at a Post  
Set in the west line of Lasal County  
By the Surveyor thereof for the SE  
corner of Dimmit and the NE corner  
of Webb said Post is 30 miles from  
the SW corner of Trio it being the NW  
corner of Lasal said Post is mkd XXX and  
D on the west W on the South and L on the  
East side Thence West 10 miles to the East  
line of the Guakin Galan Survey  
from which mile post Los Peloncis  
bears N 11° E 1100 Varas at 12 miles Cross  
the West line of said Guakin Galan  
Survey at the 17 mile post the  
Valenzuela Ranch bears N 4½° W 2½  
miles said Post is on Survey No 557  
ACH&B at 30 miles Cross the Telegraph  
road from Laredo To Eagle Pass at  
36 miles Cross Sandorenzo Creek 2½  
miles below or South of James  
Kirkpatrick's Ranch at 41 miles &  
1535 Varas plants a stone mkd XLII for  
the South West corner of this County from  
which Stone the SW corner of Sec No 9  
and the SE corner Sec No 8 in Block 7  
bears South 170 Varas.

Thence North at 4½ miles Cross



San Pedro Creek 2 miles West of Votans  
 ranch. at 23 miles goes ranch bears  
 S 45° E 450 Varas at 30 miles plants a  
 a post and stone from which the  
 NW corner of A Sanchez survey on  
 Bendencio Creek bears East 2 1/2 miles  
 Thence East at 3 miles to the west  
 line of the Terry survey on Bendencio  
 creek said line passes about 3 Varas  
 north of Terrys house at 12 miles cross  
 Panio Creek at 16 miles Espantoso  
 Lake at 21 miles cross Mueces River  
 at 41 miles & 1535 Varas to the SW  
 corner of Trino the NW corner of  
 Lasal the SE corner of Zavalla & the  
 NE corner of Dimmit

Thence South 30 miles  
 with the west line of Lasal  
 to the place of Beginning  
 containing twelve hundred  
 & fifty four square miles

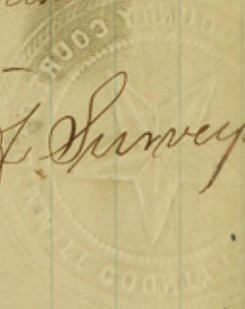
