 Surveyor appointed by Maverick Countys Com-  
 missioners Court and W. W. ~~Torrens~~ and John  
 Bell Chain Carriers duly qualified I began at  
 the S. W. Corner of Zavalla and N. W. Corner of  
 Dimmit Counties on the E. B. line of Maverick  
 County at a large Live Oak post 10 in. dia. 4 ft  
 high mkd M. D. Z. Said post stands in a slough  
 from which a Live Oak 18" in dia" mkd Z with three  
 Chops above and three below brs N 85 E 30 $\frac{3}{4}$ . Varas also  
 a Live Oak 12 in dia mkd M and four Chops above

 the East mtd  $\overline{D}$  post all mtd M West and D on East  
 Side
