FIELD NOTES OF A SURVEY OF THE BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN DONLEY AND  
ARMSTRONG COUNTY, <sup>ies</sup> TEXAS, Monday ~~May~~ <sup>June</sup> 15th., 1914.

We, R. G. Carraway, Special Surveyor for Donley County, Texas, and  
Frank Elston, Special Surveyor for Armstrong County, Texas, on ~~May~~ <sup>May</sup> 25th.,  
1914, arrived at the 42nd mile post on the 100th meridian West Longitude  
and after identifying same to our satisfaction took an observation of Polaris  
at its Eastern Elongation and measured an angle of 1 deg., 24 Min. 30 Sec.  
to the West for a true meridian, and from said meridian we measured an angle of  
90 deg. for a true West course and preceded on ~~the~~ <sup>said Tangent Line</sup> 30 miles to the Northeast  
corner of Donley, Southwest corner of Wheeler, Southeast corner of Gray and  
Northwest corner of Collingsworth Counties, from which point a Bois'd Arc post  
(marked W. on Northeast side C. on Southeast side, D. on Southwest side and  
G. on Northwest side, in Valley land sloping to the North, from which an oak  
thicket bears North 23-3/4 deg. West) bears North 226-3 vrs. and West 233 vrs.

Continuing West <sup>on said Tangent Line</sup> to a point 60 miles West of the above mentioned 42nd.  
mile post we set a cedar post 5 feet long, 3 feet in the ground, marked  
NWD. NEA. SEA. SWG., from which a large stone mound bears North 259 vrs. and  
West 441.6 vrs. from said stone mound, a windmill bears North 43-3/4 East  
Do. South 51-1/2 West two-thirds of a mile, the Southeast corner of survey  
No. 51, Blk. B3, H. & G. N. Ry. Co. bears East 52 vrs. and South 37 vrs.

THENCE SOUTH at right angles to above mentioned <sup>Tangent</sup> West line from the  
said 42nd mile post at 1900.8 vrs. set cedar post marked D. A. 1 M., South-  
east corner Survey No. 50 bears South 57 vrs. and East 56 vrs.

THENCE SOUTH at 1900.8 vrs. cedar post marked D. A. 2 M. Southeast corner  
Survey No. 49, bears East 57 vrs. and South 190 vrs.

THENCE SOUTH 1900.8 vrs. cedar post marked D. A. 3 M.

THENCE SOUTH 1900.8 vrs. cedar post marked D. A. 4 M., about 50 vrs.

THENCE SOUTH, at 1900.8 varas set cedar post Mk.D.A.<sup>5</sup> M. fence bears South 130 varas tank dam and two cottonwood trees bear about North 45 West about 200. varas.

THENCE SOUTH, at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A. 6 M. on East Slope of gravelly ridge, creek bears East about 500. varas.

THENCE SOUTH, at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A. 7 M. set stone and Bois'd Arc post, the N.W.Cor. of league No.1 of the Franklin County School Land bears South 150. varas and West 3800. varas from said 150. vara point the 23rd, mile post on the Grey Line bears North 23 deg. and 20 min. West 672 varas.

THENCE SOUTH, passing over the East edge of corral and through de-horning machine at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A. 8 M. 50. varas south of the South Bank of Salt fork of Red River in a cluster of large Willow trees.

THENCE SOUTH, at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A. 9 M. from which an iron plow land slide set for the S.E.Cor. of League No.1 of the Franklin County School Land bears East 1237.2 varas and North 516.3 varas.

THENCE SOUTH, at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A. 10 M.

THENCE SOUTH, at 634.2 varas center of County Road, at 648. varas F.W.& D.C.Ry. track, at 660. varas sign board marked One Mile To Southard bears West 5. varas, at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A. 11 M.

THENCE SOUTH, at 720. varas the S.W.Cor. of the Franklin County School Land bears West 3764. varas S.E.Cor. of League No.4 bears East 1236. varas, a Bois'd Arc post bears West 2099. varas. at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A.12 M.

THENCE SOUTH, at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A. 13 M. at head of draw.

THENCE SOUTH, at 78. varas a stone mound bears East 597. varas at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A.14 M.

THENCE SOUTH, at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A.15 M.

THENCE SOUTH, at 886. varas the S.E.Cor. of Survey No.38 G.& M. bears East 1100. varas, at 1136. varas the N.E.Cor. of Survey No.13 bears West 190. varas, at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A. 16 M. in flat of River.

THENCE SOUTH, at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A. 24 M. in large stone mound on East side of draw, from which a set stone marked X bears North 46 deg, 34 min, East 950. varas.

THENCE SOUTH, at 220. varas a stone mound one of the N.E.Corners of Survey No.105 Blk.G 5 D.&.P.Ry.Co. bears North 84 deg, 53 min, East 1756. varas at 220. varas another stone mound one of the N.E.Corners of the above mentioned Survey Bears North 84 deg, 53 min, East, 2424. varas , at 1900.8 varas set cedar post marked D.A.26.M. on mulberry flats.
