In the matter of County line between Donley and Armstrong counties.

On this the 20th day of April, 1914, it being a day of the regular March Term of the Honorable County court of Donley county, Texas, and it having been made appear to the satisfaction of the court that the boundary lines between Donley and Gray counties and between Donley and Armstrong counties is not sufficiently definite and well defined.

It is therefore ordered by the court that R.G. Caraway an experienced and competent practical surveyor be and he is hereby appointed to ascertain by actual survey the boundary lines between said Donley and Gray counties and between Donley and Armstrong counties.

That said surveyor shall begin at the N.E. corner of Collingsworth county on the 100th meridian and running from thence due West thirty miles to a point for the establishment of the N.E. corner of Donley county and the S.E. corner of Gray county. Thence Continuing West thirty miles establishing the line between Donley and Gray counties to a point for the establishment of the N.W. corner of Donley county and the N.E. corner of Armstrong county.

Thence Due South Thirty miles establishing the line between Donley and Armstrong counties to a point for the establishment of the S.W. corner of Donley county and the S.E. corner of Armstrong county.

That said boundary lines between said counties of Donley and Gray and Donley and Armstrong shall be marked and the initial corners and mile posts be established as provided in Article 1376 Revised Civil Statutes of Texas and said survey shall be made, marked, platted and field-notes and plat thereof as now provided by Title 28, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas. That said Surveyor shall be paid such fees and expenses for making said survey and for the performance of such work and labor incident thereto as is now provided by law.

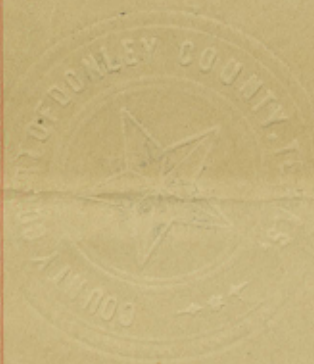
