Dear Sir:- Last June the boundary line between Armstrong and Donley Counties was run out and surveyed for the purpose of establishing a correct line between said counties. This survey was made under an agreement between these two counties, and the field notes of said survey has been recorded in the minutes of the county court for each of the counties, and the original field notes were sent to you for your approval of the survey. The field notes, I believe, were sent to by Judge Killough, County Judge of Donley county. Now what I desire to know is whether or not you have approved said survey, and if so, whether or not the boundary line between said counties was thereby established, and if it has been so established, when it became so established? If the new line is now the established line how will it affect the rights of the two counties with respect to the taxes for the year 1915 on the lands through which said new line passes?

As I understand it Armstrong county gained considerable land as a result of the new survey and if we are entitled to the taxes on this land we would like to know it.

I shall appreciate it very much if you will kindly advise me by return mail as to the status of the county boundary line. And I would like also for you to notify the Tax Assessor of Armstrong County, Mr. W. T. McLaren, if this new line has been established and is now the correct boundary line, and the exact date when it became so established.
