

Field notes of a survey establishing the East boundary of La Salle County, the West and South boundaries of McMillen County, the North boundary of Duvall County, and the South boundary of Live Oak County from the S. E. corner of McMillen County to the N. E. corner of Duvall County and N. W. corner of Kincaid County, made by the order and concurrent action of the Commissioners Courts of Duvall, Kincaid, Live Oak and McMillen Counties and their respective Surveyors under instructions and orders of the corresponding Courts of these Counties.

Beginning at the upper corner of a survey in the name of Wm. C. Horrell, assignee of Maria Jesusa Hernandez and lower corner of Survey No. 26 in the name of Julia Coates, on the South bank of Medina river where a Sycamore 11 in. in diameter, marked

the bears S. 47° N. 7' - and another 10 in. in dia. marked B bears S 47° E. 8 7/8' it being the nearest starting point accurately defined and established by law (as see Paschal's Digest Vol. 1 page 181 article 348)

Thence South, with a variation 9° 30' E. at 835 7/8' pass 20 ft East of a stake driven for



the N. W. corner of Atascosa County where  
 there are two leaning trees, on a large  
 leaning Mesquite marked  $\equiv$  at 12255<sup>00</sup>  
 crossed Atascosa creek, runs S. 45° E. at  
 13245<sup>00</sup> a fork of of the Atascosa runs  
 East, at 32520 crossed the Ciguidera creek,  
 at 51560<sup>00</sup> cross the Lajunieras creek, at  
 52.120<sup>00</sup> Rio City. road to Pleasanton East,  
 set a stone on each side of the road,  
 at 56900<sup>00</sup> Banks Hill East 20<sup>00</sup> and  
 Stone house West 45<sup>00</sup> at 62800<sup>00</sup> crossed  
 the Chiltipin - runs East, and marked  
 Live Oaks at 45310<sup>00</sup> the North San  
 Maguel - a forked lake, at 80800<sup>00</sup> the  
 North bank of the San Maguel, at 80890<sup>00</sup>  
 the lower South bank at 80920<sup>00</sup> high  
 South bank - crossing 40<sup>00</sup> East of a large  
 cottonwood on the South bank marked  $\equiv$   
 on the East side, at 81480<sup>00</sup> Pleasanton  
 and lands road. runs S. W. - at 84600<sup>00</sup>  
 set a post on a high prairie hill East  
 of the road, said post marked A on the  
 East side and F on the West side. at 84400<sup>00</sup>  
 established the N. W. corner of Mc Miller  
 County the N. E. corner of La Salle County  
 the S. E. corner of Rio County and the S. W.  
 corner of Atascosa dug a hole 2 feet deep  
 and 2 feet square, set in the center a stake,  
 in the N. E. corner was placed a small



square bottle containing a memorandum of  
the survey, date, and names of the Sur-  
veyors; the hole was then filled with pebbles  
and a mound of the same raised above;  
this mound is situated on the edge of  
a small drain, about 100 or below its  
head in an open valley on a head of  
a branch of the San Miguel, near the  
divide between said branch and the  
Paws, an open prairie drain bears N. 60° E.  
and a Live Oak Mott down said drain  
bears N. 62½° E. about 1 mile and a  
double cone Mott bears S. 44° E. about  
500 <sup>rs</sup>.

Thence South with the same variation  
at 10764 <sup>rs</sup> passed 4 <sup>rs</sup> East of a post mark-  
ed I set for the S. E. corner of survey No. 12.  
S. W. corner of survey No. 11 and N. W. corner  
of survey No. 26. all made for the Texas  
and New Orleans R. R. Co. at 12664 <sup>rs</sup>  
passed 4 <sup>rs</sup> East of a post marked X set  
for the S. W. Corner of survey No. 26 above  
mentioned, at 12765 <sup>rs</sup> Esperanzas Creek runs  
East, at 12910 <sup>rs</sup> recrossed same, and crossed  
again at 12935 <sup>rs</sup> and left same at 12990 <sup>rs</sup>  
at 14440. crossed road from Kerr and  
Strees Ranch to Pleasanton a Mesquite mark-  
ed X bears East 5½ <sup>rs</sup> at 15200 <sup>rs</sup> set  
the 8<sup>th</sup> mile post, marked 8 on the North

side N. on the East, and I. on the West side, at 16590 <sup>rs</sup> the Esperanzas and Lawhorn road which crosses the Rio at Joe Lawhorn ranche, at 17364 <sup>rs</sup> the North end of King hills bears S. 60° E, at 21700 <sup>rs</sup> crossed a deep lake 15 <sup>rs</sup> wide, at 23345 <sup>rs</sup> center of the Rio River in a small bend, ~~set a post marked I and then S. E. and~~

S. W. at 23395 <sup>rs</sup> a Hackberry marked X bears East 1 <sup>rs</sup>, at 26770 <sup>rs</sup> road running up the river from Dayton or Pilden at 27400 <sup>rs</sup> North end of King hills bears S. 77 3/4° E, at 28500 <sup>rs</sup> set a post marked XV and a stone, at 34500 <sup>rs</sup> passed 2 <sup>rs</sup> East of a lone Mesquite on a hill, marked ≡ on the East side and X on the West side, at 35900 <sup>rs</sup> first Pacaguiste branch runs East-, at 36386 <sup>rs</sup> passed 4443 <sup>rs</sup> West of a post marked V set for the S. W. corner of survey No. 9, the N. W. of No. 10 the N. E. of No. 5 and S. E. corner of survey No. 4 made for the Gulf, Western Texas and Pacific R. R. Co. where a stone petrified mesquite, on an island in a branch of Elm creek, marked X and V bears S. 82° W 328 <sup>rs</sup>, at 36100 <sup>rs</sup> set a post and made a stone mound of petrified live oak, on the North side of a hill, at 41500 <sup>rs</sup> the North point



of King hills bears N.  $70\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., at 46620 the  
King hills bear N.  $66^{\circ}$  E. San Cajo bears S.  
 $82^{\circ}$  E. Chusa S.  $54\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. and Loma Alta  
bears S.  $43^{\circ}$  E. at 47500 <sup>21</sup> the 25<sup>th</sup> mile  
built a stone mound of petrified wood.  
at 52980 <sup>21</sup> road from Landa to San  
Antonio, by the side of which was built  
a mound of stone, at 56290 <sup>22</sup> crossed  
Green Creek and with the same at  
56560 left the creek, it flowing S. E.  
by E. at 57940 a stone mound on first  
hill after crossing Green branch at 62720  
Loma Alta bears S.  $64^{\circ}$  E. at 66050 Loma

 a branch, at 28500 set the 15<sup>th</sup> mile post,  
 marked M on the North side D on the  
 South and XV on the West side - the West  
 edge of Loma Alta bears N.  $3^{\circ}$  W. and the  
 East side N.  $2^{\circ}$  E. at 32849<sup>ms</sup> passed 535<sup>ms</sup>
