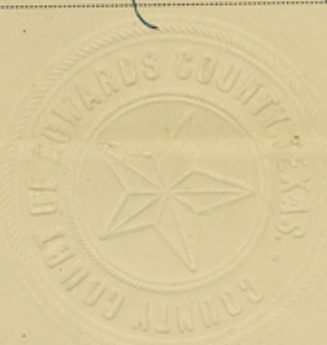

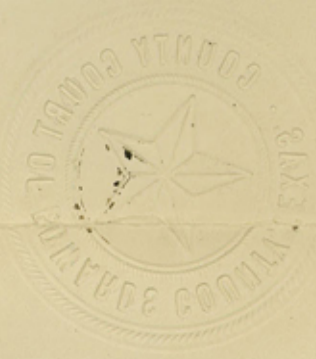

to meet me at the time and place appointed and I proceeded to run the north line making connections as shown by field notes. I ran this line at right-angle with Kerr Co west-line on variation $9^{\circ} 3' 8''$ to a point 22 miles west of the N.W. Corner of Kerr Co.

I then commenced at N.W. Corner of Kerr Co and ran South 25 miles to the N.W. Corner of Bandera Co. with West-line of Kerr County. I then met Judge McCormack appointed from Uvalde Co. assisted by Mr. Bennett these gentlemen had just finished their line with Bandera Co and had been running on $9^{\circ} 55' 42''$ E. Mr. Pock of Bandera having accepted this variation I done the same we ran West 21 miles from the 21st mile on Uvalde South line making connections as shown by field notes.

I then met Mr. Louis Pock at the N.W. corner of Bandera Co. We ran on variation of $9^{\circ} 3'$ a continuation of the Edwards east-line and at-

The Appointee of Kimble County failed
to meet me at the time and place appointed
and I proceeded to run the north line making
connections as shown by field notes. I ran
this line at right-angle with Kerr Co West-
line on variation $9^{\circ} 3' E$ to a point 22 miles
West of the N.W. Corner of Kerr Co.

I then commenced at N.W. Corner of Kerr Co
and ran South 25 miles by 3 rods to the N.W.
Corner of Bandera Co. With West line of Kerr County
I then met Judge Mc Cormack Appointee from
Uvalde Co. assisted by Mr. Bennett these gentlemen
had just finished their line with Bandera Co
and had been running on $9^{\circ} 55' E$ Mr. Polk of
Bandera having accepted this variation I done the
same. we ran West 21 miles from the 21st mile
on Uvalde South line making connections
