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In re-running of this county line we were controlled by three fixed points, a point on the West Bank of Trinity River one mile west and one mile north of the old Col. Robert H. Porter house; next, the mouth of Mill Creek, and next, the common corner of Navarro and Hill on the southern line of Ellis County, which is 55 varas North 602, and 1690 varas N 30 W from the northwest corner of the Navarro County School Land league survey, and a tangent was run

from the point on the River back of the mouth of Mill Creek, and also on a tangent from the mouth of Mill Creek to the Navarro-Hill corner on the Ellis County southerly line.
