To the Hon J B Cox Judge of
County Court of Fannin County:
The undersigned ordered by the Judges of the
respective Counties aforesaid to survey out
and establish the boundary line between
said Counties by leave to report that we
have completed the same in pursuance of
said order and submit the following as
our report together with the accompanying
Sketch of the same and surveys contiguous
to said line which is made a part of our
report. Beginning on the south bank of
Red River at the mouth of Choctaw Bay
we planted a bois darc post 50 vrs south
of the bank of said River 8 inches in diam-
eter marked on the East side N W cor
F. C. and West side N E cor G. C. from which
an Elm. marked G. C. brs S 71° N 2 3/4 vrs and
a bois darc tree marked F. C brs S 5° N 14 1/2
Varas Course of the river bears S 74° E
thence South on a magnetic variation of
8° degrees East at 1205 vrs cross the East
line of the John Decker survey at 1480 vrs a
lake at 1850 vrs planted Post marked 1 M.
2nd South on the second mile at 155 vrs
cross the N line of the B F Fitch survey 184
vrs N 84° E from said Fitch's N W cor at 955 vrs

Cross the South line of said Fitch and the North line of Daniel Montayne 413 2/3 N 84° E from their corners on the West, continuing South at 1220 2/3 a branch Course South East at 1900 2/3 set a post marked 2 M.

3rd Thence South on the third mile at 410 2/3 cross the Bear branch Course South East at 1900 2/3 set a post marked 3 M in prairie.

4th South on the 4th mile at 85 2/3 cross the S line of said Montayne Survey and the N line of the Jesse Wallace Survey 1188 2/3 East of Montayne's S W cor and 558 2/3 East from said Wallace's N W cor and 1688 2/3 West from this E W corner Con-South at 1842 2/3 a branch C- South East at 1900 2/3 set a post 4. M "

5th Thence South on the 5th mile at 620 2/3 a branch C- East at 1048 2/3 cross the South line of said Wallace and North line of Charles Daugherty 298 2/3 from said Wallace's S W cor. and 522 2/3 from his S.E. cor. and 838 2/3 from said Daugherty's N W cor. Con-South at 1900.8 2/3 set Post marked 5 M in field on the East side of Small stream.

6th South on the 6th mile at 815 2/3 cross the South line of said Daugherty and North line of N.E. Briant 667 2/3 from said Daugherty's S W cor and 838 2/3 from said Briant's N W cor. Con-South at 1780

was a branch Co. South East at 1900.8 was set
Post in brushy timber mtd 6. M. on N bank
of a small branch.

7th South on the 7th mile at 55 was to brushy
bank. Course S.E. at 21.3 was cross the South
line of David Bryant and the North line of
the John Weeks Survey 703 was N 84° E from
their corner. Con. South at 1140 was Savoy
Road Co. S.E. at 1360 was a branch Co. S.E. at
1900.8 was set Post mtd 7. M. in field about
40 was West of a branch Co. N.E.

8th South on the 8th mile at 1735 was cross
the Texas and Pacific Rail Road at 1900.8
was set Post mtd 8 M in prairie.

9th South on 9th mile at 100 was cross
branch Co. East at 820 was to a point West of
Savoy about one half mile at 1000 was
cross the S line of said Weeks Survey and N
line of A. J. Journey 804 was East of David
Weeks S. W. cor. and 504 was East from said
Journey. N. W. ^{cor} con. South at 1870 was Caney
Creek Course East at 1900.8 was set Post
mtd 9 M 10 was West of Browders Tank.

10th South on 10th mile at 33 was cross the
South line of said Journey and N line of
E. Daniel Survey 571 was East from his S
W cor. (Journeys) at 1900.8 was set Post mtd
10 M in Browders field.

11th Thence South on the 11th mile at

1609 2nd cross the S line of said Daniels survey and the N boundary line of University League No 2. 1050 2nd East from said Daniels South West corner. continuing South between the University lands of Grayson and Francisco Cos at 1900.8 2nd set Post marked 11 M in Hortons field.

12th South on 12th mile at 1720 2nd to Centre of Judge Bryants House at 1900.8 2nd set Post marked 12 M in his field.

13th South on 13th mile at 1900.8 2nd set Post marked 13 M in Prairie.

13th South on 13th mile at 1900.8 2nd set Post marked 13 M in Prairie.

14th South on 14th mile at 940 2nd cross the Kentucky town and Benham road at 1145 2nd to Bois darc cross course East at 1400 2nd cross the N line of the N N Anderson survey 760 2nd East from his N N cor. cor. South at 1900.8 2nd set post in field marked 14 M

15th South on the 15th mile at 700 2nd pass a point East of Whitwright at 1180 2nd to Muthers house at 1430 2nd branch course South East at 1900.8 2nd set Post marked 15 M about 80 2nd West of the Sears Chapel.

16th South on the 16th mile at 500 2nd cross the S line of said Anderson Sur and N

Boundary line of the University Lands of Stan-
min & Grayson Counties, 860 ^{ms} East from
said Andersons South West corner, continuing
South at 1900.8 ^{ms} set Post marked 16 M.

17th South on 17th mile at 1900.8 ^{ms} set
Post ^{in Road} marked 17 M.

18th South on the 18th mile at 370 ^{ms} ^{Cross} ^{the}
Mo. Pacific Rail Road at 1900.8 ^{ms} set
Post marked 18 M.

19th South on the 19th mile at 1900.8 ^{ms}
set post marked 19 M in thickets.

20th South on the 20th mile at 1900.8 ^{ms}
set post marked 20 M

21st South on the 21st mile at 630 ^{ms} a
branch C- West at 1600 ^{ms} to a branch C-
South West at 1800 ^{ms} to a small stream
at 1900.8 ^{ms} set post marked 21 M in prairie.

22nd South on the 22nd mile at 780 ^{ms}
branch C- West at 1900.8 ^{ms} set post marked
22 M.

23rd. South on the 23rd mile at 380 ^{ms}
to the S.E. corner of Grayson County set
Post marked S.E. cor G.C. on the North side
and F.C. on East side and N.E. cor C.C. on
South side the bearing of this corner is down-
but identified by original bearing as also
by marked line running West and North
all the Posts marked G.C. on West side and
F.C. on East side thus completing said line
