AN ACT

Better to define the Boundaries of the County of Fannin.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Republic of Texas in Congress assembled, That hereafter the boundaries of the county of Fannin shall be as follows: Beginning at the mouth of Bois d' Arc creek on Red River; thence up said creek with the meanders thereof to the crossing at the residence of Carter T. Cliff; thence south so far as to make sixty miles from the place of beginning on a straight line; thence west to a point south of the head of the upper Washita; thence north to Red River, and down the same with the meanders thereof, to the place of beginning; Provided however, that no surveying which may have heretofore been made within the limits herein mentioned by the legally authorized surveyors of any county bordering on the same, shall be made void by the passage of this act.
