Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup>, May, A.D. 1877.

This day came on to be heard the petition of citizens of Fayette Co., praying for an order to have the County line between Fayette & Colorado Counties, survey\_ & marked out, as follows: Beginning at the West Bank of the Colorado River. Thence to Survey and mark out said line to the point where Lavaca Colorado & Fayette Counties joins and it appearing to the court that there exist a necessity for the location of said line. It is ordered by the Court that the County Surveyor proceed in accordance with this order and in company with the surveyor of Colorado Co., to survey and mark out said line. It is further ordered by the court that the clerk of this court furnish the County Judge of Colorado Co. with a copy of this order, asking him to make a similar order in his county so that both surveyors can act in concert.

Whereas a\_ order was issued by the  
Hon. Comm'r. Court of Fayette County on May the 16th. A. D.1877,  
to survey and mark out the line between the county of Fayette  
and the County of Colorado to the County Surveyor of Fayette County  
to join the County surveyor of Colorado County and to act in  
concert. Therefore we the surveyors of the said two Countys  
after executing the work lawfully and according to the order  
report as follows: Field notes of a survey of the line divid-  
ing Fayette and Colorado County's made according to an Act  
passed by the Legislature on Feb.11th. 1854, fixing the corner  
of Lavaca-Colorado & Fayette County's on the Navidad at the  
N.E. of a survey for Marmadecke Standifur and the other end  
of the line ordered to be runned from the East bank of the Co-  
lorado river the upper corner of the Joseph Duty league and  
the said line is more fully described as follows, to-wit:  
Beginning at the mouth of a deep ravine on the East side of  
the Colorado river which is the upper corner of the Joseph Duty  
league and lower corner of J. Petty league, thence running S.  
39 W. crossing the river at a half mile crossing the river  
again thence at a mile crossing the river another time and to  
the west side a Cottonwood is marked F/C and a Hackberry mkd.  
Fayette Co. line. Thence through low bottom crossing a fine  
spring and to a groupe of four Live Oaks standing on a hill  
at the enterance of the prairie one is marked Fayette, one  
Colorado and one Co. line. Thence continuing the same course  
through prairie and fields to a rock mkd. F.C. about 50 vs.  
W. of Wm. Mango(s house (a.f.m.c.) Thence same course passing  
about 50 vs. West of a tenant house belonging to Ed. Adams.

Dittmar the County Surveyor of Colorado County in conjunction with the County Surveyor of Fayette County to begin on a certain place on the Colorado river and to make connection with a place on the line of Austin County and that they shall makè due report to their respective Commissioner\_ Courts of their Countys & we the undersigned County Surveyors of Colorado and Fayette Countys have therefore acted under the said order and likewise order issued of the court in Fayette County, report as follows: After an carefull\_ examination of all the County records we found nothing in regard to the line between the Countys of Fayette and Colorado, except an act passed by the Legislature of the State of Texas, Dec.14, A.D. 1837, (P\_\_\_ Digest Art. 323) fixing the North corner of Colorado County with is also the East corner of Fayette County at the S.W. corner of a league of land granted to Wm. Burnett. Thence to run S.W. wardly crossing the Colorado river where the upper line of the J.Duty corners upon the same we therefore proceeded in compliance to the said act and started at the South West corner of Wm. Burnett league with is situated in Austin County and Thence runned S. W. and as we failed to make connection with the upper corner of J. Duty league on the river we went to the place and started backwards and runned marked and established the true line between the Countys of Colorado and Fayette with runs N. 38° E. by a variation of 10° E. and is described as follows, to-wit. The upper corner of the J. Duty league on the East bank of the river is a Hackberry mkd. D. and two Hackberrys pointers mkd. H. Thence N. 38° E. passing E. of some rent houses, on Dutys league and East of Estels house, a P.O.mkd. F.C. Thence passing 75 vs. E. of J. Dutys North corner a P.O.

Fayette and Colorado Counties as ordered by the Commissioner  
Courts of the said two Counties in accordance with an Act  
passed by the 16th. Legislature April 22, 1879, entitled an  
Act establishing and prescribing the manner of ascertaining  
the boundaries of counties (General Laws of 79, page 137)  
The said line is described in Article 777 on page 129, which  
reads as follows from the South West corner of a league of  
land granted to Wm. Burnett to the upper corner of the  
Joseph Duty's league on the East side of the Colorado river  
and continuing in the direction of the upper corner of a  
league of land for Wm. Ponton on Lavaca river to the Lavaca  
County line. The part of the line on the West side of the  
river after running a trial line from the upper corner of J.  
Duty league or Colorado river, which is a distance of 46,679  
vs. or 24-1/2 miles to ascertain the course of the true line  
which turned out to be S. 41° 40' W. Thence set a post on  
E. bank of said river for upper corner of J. Duty's league,  
said Post is like the balance, 5 feet long 8 inches square  
of Cypress timber three feet in the ground with the initials  
of the County's on the respective sides and 1879 on the  
S.W. side and B. for beginning on N.E. side. Thence at 164  
vs. across the river at 684 vs to the river again and 819  
to other side of the river at 1799 vs to the river again  
putting the first mile post in the river which was at that  
place 164 vs wide after 1000 vs. living bottom second mile  
post set in Taylor pasture which is mkd. C on Colorado side  
and F..on Fayette side and II on side towards the river and  
1879 on side towards Navidad. Thence 1900 vs. to third mile  
post on hill in W. Mangos field mkd. III and the initials of  
the County's Thence 157 vs. crossing line running N. and S.  
at 1900 vs. set the 4th. mile post about 120 vs. North of  
Wm. Bufferds dwelling house. Thence passing N.W. of Mitchels  
house 1900 vs. set the 5th. mile post some 300 vs. W. of

Thence 1900 vs. set the 7 mile post in John Holmans pasture. Thence at 620 vs. pass the West line of H. Austin 5 leagues 1900 vs. set 8 mile post on N. side of DeGraffenrieds branch. Thence 759 vs. crossing Murchisons East line 33 vs. S. of the S.W. corner of a survey of 211 acres for the heirs of Elizabeth Windle and East line of J.A.Sergeant league and passing 15 vs. N. W. of Woods dwelling at 1697 vs. crossing the tract of the G.H. and S.A.R.R. a little West of the curve West of Weimar at 1900 vs. the 9 mile post. Thence at 560 vs. passing the South corner of Thom Chandlers dwelling and about 150 vs. South of the old Chandler place at 1900 vs. set the 10 mile post on the Weimar and Schulenburg road also on the North line of the J.G.O.Ferrell league and 44 vs. N. 80° E. from the N.E. corner of Wm. Blaks 100 acres survey. Thence 1900 vs. set the 11 mile post N.E. of the old Peerce place now Allens place. Thence 600 vs. passing a little South of Allens S.W. corner 917 vs. passing Kozureks S. cor. in a ravine 1900 vs. set the 12 mile post on South side of a branch running about West in to East Navidad. Thence 1900 vs set a 13 mile post inside of Cranchos or now McNellys field about 200 vs. S.E. of Navidad bottom. Thence through Thom Bassfield to 14 mile post in Navidad bottom 100 vs. N.E. of the Channel. Thence 100 vs. to the South line of the Burnham league, which is the North boundary line of Lavaca County set likewise post.

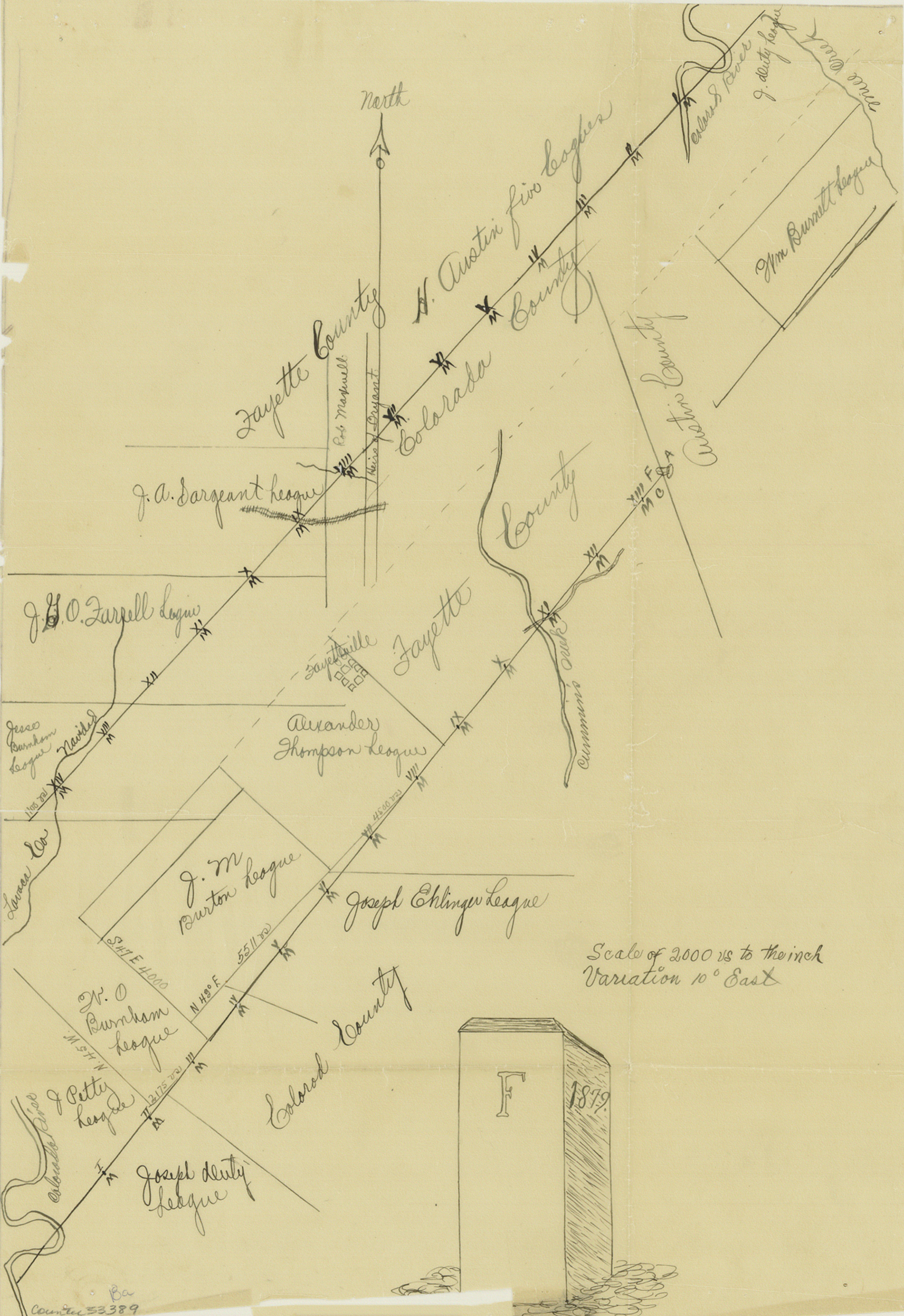
