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This day August 12th. 1885, came on to be heard the Report of R. A. Doss, County Surveyor in regard to the survey and establishment of the County line between between Fayette and Washington County and it appearing to the Court that said Report is accompanied by the Field notes and plot of said County line and seems to be correct, it is ordered by the Court that said report be adopted and recorded as required by law.

County of Fayette. | Report of a survey of the Fayette and Washington County line as agreed to by the surveyors R. A. Doss & H. R. v. Bieberstein and the following are the correct field notes and description of the marks, roads & other objects:-

Beginning at the most western corner of Austin County as established by the surveyors in 1882 a Post mkt. the letters F.A.W. engraved on the highest point in the dividing ridge of the waters of the Brazos & Colorado rivers & in the N.W. bdy. line of the David Shelby league 720 vs. N. 43° E. from her West corner. Thence N. 4-1/2° W. at 1000 passed near the head of a branch of Mill Creek at 1600 vs. set a post No. I & F.W. engraved in the line of the Gill & the Townsend surveys 820 vs. N. 45° E. from the South corner of sd. S. Townsend 1/4 league. Thence continuing the same course but from No. I at 800 vs. pass the head of a branch run to Cummings Creek at 1375 vs to a rockwalled well in H.J. Marburgers yard. Thence N. 55½° W. 900 vs. a post Oak 10 inches in Diameter near the head of a branch of Mill Creek mkd. F.W. Thence N. 29° W. 650 vs. set a Post No. II & F. W. engraved in the line of the J. Townsend 1/4 league 762 vs. S. 43 W. from its East corner also the N. corner of the S. Townsend 1/4. Thence continuing the same course 169 vs. more to a stake fr. w. a Post Oak mkd. F. brs. S. 13° W. 6 vs. a do W. N. 8½° vs. Thence N. 13° E. 822 vrs. cross the S.W. bdy. line



of the J.Fletcher league 580 vs. N. 47° W. from the East  
corner of the W.S.Townsend 1/4 league, continuing line course  
1047 vs. Post Oak tree mkd. F.W. & 15 east of Wm. Marburger  
dwelling house. Thence N. 2° W. passing 17 vs. N. 36° E. of  
Fieles North corner, at 1420 vs. set post No.III on N. side  
of Burton road. Thence same course N. 2° W. at 1300 vs. from  
No.III crossed the N.W. line of the J.Fletcher league 547 vs  
N. 43° E. from the west corner of Jack Grants & the south of  
Harvey Lewis tracts of land & 2107 vs from the west corner of  
the Jos. Fletcher league at 1429 vs. a Post Oak tree F.W.  
about 30 vs. N.E. of Harvey Lewis Dwelling house and 1-1/2  
vs. East of the Stake. Thence N. 22° W. 2040 vs. set Post No.  
IV at the west corner of Abendroths and the North corner of  
Meinkis tracts in the N.W. line of the John Schultz 1/3  
league & the S. E. line of the Ch.Fleasner 1/3 league and 1000  
vs. S. 43° W. fr the North corner of the John Schultz 1/3  
league. Thence N. 48° W. 1925 vs. set post No.V at Wm. Johles  
South corner in the S.E.Bdy. line of the Jos. Beardslee league  
628 vs. S. 45° W. from the East corner & on the La Grange  
Round Top & Burton Road. Thence N. 20-1/2° E. at 690 cross  
Beardslee & S.W. bdy. line of O.Hudson league 292 vs. N. 45°  
W. from their S. & East corners, at a distance of 2160 vs.  
an line course set Post No.VI, on the Round Top & Union hill  
road N. 41 1/2° E. 315 vs. from Thieles East corner. Thence N.  
72° W. pass E. of Gerlands house at 1800 vs. set Post No.VII  
at the W. cor. of H.House's 45 acre tract & the S. corner of  
Koerts tract. Thence N. 83° W. at 830 vs. cross the N.E. bdy.  
line of the J.Beardslee league & the line of the O.Hudson,  
league at a distance of 1900 vs cross track of the W. branch  
of H. & T.C.R.R. & at 2060 vs. passing over the West corner  
of Lorenz Fuchs timber tract which is also the S. corner of  
Knickes timber tract & at 2380 vs. from No. VII set Post No.  
VIII in the line dividing the Feist & Kihn tracts. Thence N.  
13° W. 1780 vs. a Post No. IX in the N.E. line of the Jos.  
Beardslee league 2350 S.E. of her N.Corner. Thence S. 63 W.

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1900 vs. set Post No. X in the West edge of a small Prairie at the head of the section house branch. Thence S.  $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. at 2000 vs. set Post No. XI, on the South side of the R.R. Reservation at 280 vs. more a stake. Thence N.  $80^{\circ}$  W. 650 vs. set a post No. XII on the South side of the R.R. reservation. Thence on same course 1700 vrs. more to where we set Post No. XIII in the N.W. bdy. line of the Mary Phelps league. 327 vs. S.  $45^{\circ}$  W. from the E. corner of a survey for McHenry Winnburn & 690 vs. N.  $45^{\circ}$  E. from the West corner of the Mary Phelps league. Thence S.  $73^{\circ}$  W. 2650 vs. setting Post No. XIV on the South side of R.R. reserv. Thence continuing same course 100 vs. to a point S.W. of gravel pit set Post No. XV. Thence N.  $25^{\circ}$  W. at 425 vs. cross R. R. Track 1540 vs. set Post No. XVI in the N.E. bdy. line of the DeWitt League. Thence N.  $67^{\circ}$  W. 900 vs. Post No. XVII in the S.E. bdy. line of the town of Ledbetter 340 vs. S.  $45^{\circ}$  W. from the E. corner of it in the N.E. bdy. line of the G. DeWitt league. Thence N.  $54^{\circ}$  W. 1950 vs. to the corner Post mkd. F.W & LEE engraved in the respective sides, it is set in the N.W. bdy. line of the G. DeWitt league 650 vs. S.  $45^{\circ}$  W. from her North corner, all the posts are of allheart Cypress, 8x8 inches & 5 feet long & are set 3 feet into the ground, the initials & numbers are engraved & the Posts are painted white & initials black. The above survey was made & all the Posts set on the following days of June 8th., 9th., 10th., 11th., 12, 13-15 & 16th., A.D. 1885.
