I, W. M. Massie, County Surveyor of Floyd County, Texas duly qualified to determine the connections between the North & West lines of Floyd County (as located by T. J. Crews, Special Surveyor Appointed to locate said lines) with the surveys which are intersected by said County lines or which are adjacent or near said lines.

I determined said connections in the following manner: I made direct connection between the North line of Floyd County and a large Earthen Monumental corner, which corner is the original ^{N.W.} Cor. of Sur. No 1 Blk. D 2 and also of ^{S.W. cor.} Sur. No. 49 Blk. 4 M as is described in record of Floyd County Field Notes, and from and with regard to said connection all surveys in Blks. 4 M, D 2, D 5, & D 6 which tie directly from said Monumental corner which are connected with said County line, were carefully plotted in using course and distance, as is plainly & correctly shown by the field notes and map of said Co. line as has been made by the said T. J. Crews.

I also made direct connection between the N. E. Cor. of League No. 2 Callahan County School Land Auct. ^{Floyd Co.} line and also the S. E. corner of League No. 3 Callahan County School Land Auct. ^{Floyd Co.} line, and also the N. W. Cor. Sur. No. 1 Blk. C J & 4 M and ^{Floyd Co.} line, and from and with regard to said connections I plotted in ^{the surveys which connect along the West line,} Blk. N, Callahan County Leagues Nos.

2 and 3, Blk. K, Blks. C2 & C in S.W. por-
tion of County, giving Blk. N Course and
distance from the middle corner of Calla-
han Land, (N.W. Cor of League No 1 and N.E. Cor.
League No. 2) Callahan land plotted from
the connections made from its own corners
as has been mentioned (The middle Cor.
of the ^{Callahan Co.} H. Leagues could not be found, that
is the S.E. Cor. Sur. No. 2, S.W. ^{Cor.} No. 1, N.W. No. 4 and
N.E. No. 3) Blk. K is plotted from the N.W.
corner of survey no. 1 Blk. C, T. & 4. N., which
is an original large earthen monumental
corner as is described in the Floyd County
record of field notes, and since Blks. C2 & C
in S.W. part of Floyd County is directly
connected from the S.E. Cor. of Sur. No.
