

1 The State of Texas } Be it remembered that at the
2 County of Freestone } November Term 1879, of the
3 Hon, Commissioners Court of
4 said County the following order judgment &
5 decree was made and entered on the Minutes
6 of said Court to wit:

7 " At this term of the Court came on to be
8 heard the Report of the Surveyors of Freestone &
9 Navarro Counties, who had been appointed
10 by the Commissioners Courts of said Counties,
11 of the field notes of the survey of the boundary
12 line of said Counties together with a plot
13 showing the locality of said boundary line
14 which Report is as follows to wit:

The State of Texas
County of Freestone ^{mm} Field Notes of The Boundary
Line between the Counties of Freestone and Navarro
State of Texas, as run by W. C. Day County Surveyor
of Freestone County and Henry N. Parrad County
Surveyor of Navarro County in the months of August
and September A. D. 1879.

Beginning at a large Rock in a prairie, for the Common
corner of Freestone, Limestone and Navarro Counties, which
bears S. 11° W. 785 varas from the N. W. corner of the R. B.
Longbotham 21. Labor Survey.

Thence N. 60° E { Variation 3° 30' E } - at 180 varas
cross the west line of said Longbotham survey - at 1800
varas pass Henry Johnson's house about 200 varas in
1. M. Freestone County - at 1. Mile, a post in said Johnson's field

- at 1. mile and 1100 varas pass J. D. Bounds house
about 200 varas in Navarro County - at 1. mile and
1550 varas cross the E. line of Turner Smith's survey 1010
2. M. varas North of his S. E. corner - at 2. Miles a post -

at 2. miles 1540 varas cross Houston & Texas Central
Railroad, marking a lone Post Oak "C.L." which stands
about 35 varas N. of the line - 2. miles and 1700 varas
pass J. A. Bounds house about 200 varas in Freestone
3. M. County - at 3. Miles a post - at 3. miles 650 varas cross

the S. E. line of the A. Nick's survey S 35° W 140 varas

a post - at 8 miles and 1573 varas cross P. C. Wilson's
West line N 30 W 564 varas from the S. W. corner of
the same, which is also the S. W. corner of the Cartwell
9. M. Howard survey - at 9 Miles a post - at 9 miles
300 varas cross Old Stage road from Fairfield to
Georsicana - at 9 miles 845 varas cross the N. W. line
of the H. Howard survey and S. E. line of the P. C.
Wilson survey S 35 W 338 varas from said Wilson's
S. E. corner - passing E. J. Brown's house about 180 varas
in Navarro County and Ansel Coleman's house about
10. M. 400 varas in Freestone County - at 10 Miles a post
- at 10 miles and 1330 varas passed Hood's house about
200 varas in Navarro County - at 10 miles and 1796
varas cross the W. line of the J. C. Freeman & Henson's
survey S. 30 E 37 varas from N. E. corner of the H. C.
11. M. & 12. M. Howard survey - at 11 Miles a post - at 12 Miles a
post near the S. W. corner of James Coopers pasture
- at 12 miles and 300 varas pass James Cooper's
house about 300 varas in Freestone County -

- at 12. miles and 1520 varas crossed the East line of
the Jas. L. Moss survey 130 E 106 varas from the N.E
corner of same - at 13. Miles a post - at 14. Miles a
Stake on the West bank of a branch whence a Pine Oak
9. in dia marked $\frac{X}{X}$ bears S 73 E 7 1/2 varas, passing the
old Hayes house about 250 varas in Navarro
County - at 14. miles 1450 varas passed Austin Clarke
house about 100 varas in Navarro County - at 14. miles
1820 varas passed through a log cabin on Austin
Clarke's place - at 15 Miles a Stake whence a Post Oak
12 in dia marked $\frac{X}{X}$ bears S 44 W 13 varas - at 16 Miles
a post in Mrs Kelly's field & house in Navarro County
- at 16. miles and 1150 varas passed County Line
Spring about 150 varas in Navarro County - at
16. miles 1350 varas crossed Spring branch - at
16. miles and 1600 varas passed Widow Eppes' house in
Freestone County - at 17. Miles a Stake whence a
Hickory $\frac{X}{X}$ 8. in dia. bears N 45 1/2 W 3. varas and a
Hickory $\frac{X}{X}$ 10 in dia. bears N 85 1/2 W 5. varas - at 17. miles
and 760. varas passed Warrick Whitstones house
about 50 varas in Navarro County - at 18. Miles
a Stake whence a 3. pronged Post Oak $\frac{X}{X}$ 12. 12 & 14. in
dia. bears N 23 W 10 varas - at 18 miles 580 varas
Anderson's School House 20 varas in Freestone
County - at 18. miles and 1071 varas passed through
Hazzard Anderson's house - at 19 Miles a post
in the prairie near Dr J. B. Grayson's - at 19. miles
and 200 varas passed Dr J. B. Grayson's house
about 200 varas in Freestone County - at 19. miles
and 600 varas passed William Mayo's house about
6. varas in Navarro County - at 19. miles and

and found a Post Oak 16. in. dia marked "C.L." on a

an Elm 6 in. dia. marked X

at 29 miles and 980
varas crossed the Louisiana and Wild Cat road
and marked an Ash and a Pin Oak "C.L." - at 29.
miles and 1300 varas a stake on the West bank of the

Trinity River and found an Ash 12. in. dia marked
"C.L." which bears N 69 W 4 varas and an Overcup Oak
32 in. dia marked "C.L." which bears S 53 E 5 varas.

These trees are called for in the field notes of a survey
made by John Loughridge January 3^d 1856. We
marked them X, and also marked an Ash 14. in.
dia X which bears S 59 W 9. varas. Line marked with four hicks.
