

On this the 15th day of September 1914, there came on to be considered the establishment of the North line of Garza County, Texas, and it appearing to the Court that there is uncertainty as to the true and proper location by of said line.

It is ordered by the court that said line be surveyed, marked and monuments erected as provided by law, Chapter 4, Title 28 of the Revised Statutes of 1911, of the State of Texas, and that should said line be found to cross any survey of land the field notes of said County line shall show the point in said survey lines where the County line crosses survey line, giving distance from survey corners and showing number of acres of such survey contained in each Garza and Crosby Counties.

It is further ordered that the survey between Garza and Crosby Counties shall begin at The Northwest corner of Bent and the South West corner of Dickens Counties, on the 19th day of October 1914.

It further appearing to the Court that W.R. Standefer of Lubbock County, Texas is an experienced and competent practical surveyor it is ordered that he be appointed and he is hereby appointed to ascertain and establish by actual survey, the line of Garza County, as hereinabove ordered.

It is further ordered that the Clerk of this Court mail or deliver a copy of the above and foregoing order to the County Court of Crosby County, Texas as is provided by law.
