

In County Commissioners Court of Gillespie  
County, Texas, 1889.

To the Honorable County Commissioners  
Court of Gillespie County.

In obedience to the order of Court  
given at the February Term 1889 by which I  
was appointed to represent Gillespie County  
in running and establishing the County-  
line, between Kerr and Gillespie Counties - have  
the honor to report that I have proceeded in  
said matter, have met J. H. Davis the sur-  
veyor of Kerr County, and that we together, as-  
sisted by George Sawley, Hears Boecking, H.  
DeShert, and Chas Rausch did commence the  
work at the appointed time. - Beginning  
at a point S. 17° W. 18000 varas from where  
the old Texas and Travis Dist. line crosses  
the Pedernales river, said point being the  
S. E. corner of Gillespie County, as recently es-  
tablished. Thence running west we ascer-  
tained, that there is an old marked line  
in existence, same being considerably South  
of where the Southline of Gillespie County, pro-  
perly should have been marked. After ar-  
riving at the San Antonio and Fredericks-  
burg road, or at a distance of 24570 varas  
west from the S. E. corner of Gillespie Co. we  
ran South several hundred varas, to the  
old line above mentioned; thence running  
west we retraced the same, for a distance  
of 4000 or 5000 varas, after that the course  
of the old line changes to the right, at a  
distance of 11396 varas west from the San  
Antonio road, at a point on the westline

1 of Kendall County, we found the old line  
2 north of said point. Having thus ascer-  
3 tained that an old marked line existed,  
4 J. H. Davis the Surveyor of Kerr County and  
5 myself could not agree on the line to be  
6 run between Kerr and Gillespie Counties. -

7 The Surveyor of Kerr County held that the old  
8 marked line, could not be accepted as  
9 the boundary line between Gillespie and Kerr  
10 Counties for the following reason viz: 1)  
11 because the same is incorrect 2) because  
12 no report of same has been made, accord-  
13 ing to law. 3) because same is not the  
14 line designated and described by the act  
15 creating Gillespie Co., 4) because there is no  
16 legal record of same. -

17 I held, that the old line should be accepted  
18 as the true boundary line between Gillespie  
19 and Kerr Counties, for the reason that said  
20 line is found marked on the ground. -

21 As is in such cases provided by law, we, Mr.  
22 J. H. Davis and myself, reported the question  
23 at issue between us, as well as the facts  
24 in the case, to the Hon., R. M. Hall Commis-  
25 sioner of the General Land Office, praying  
26 for his decision. The Commissioners de-  
27 cision sustained the argument of J. H.  
28 Davis and overruled my opinion. The  
29 Commissioners answer being in substance  
30 as follows;

Dear Sir;

Replying to your communication of date in regard to the line between Kerr and Gillespie Counties, have to say that the result desired in re-running the boundary lines between Counties, is to have them correct. So, if the line between Gillespie and Kerr Cos. as run by Mr. Kueschler is found to be erroneous, either in the beginning point, or in the course of the line, it must be disregarded in so far, as the error exists, notwithstanding the line may be found marked on the ground.

Sir: - Replying to yours of the 25<sup>th</sup> inst: I will state that the S. E. corner of Gillespie Co. established by Gillespie Co. and Blanco Co. Surveyors recently shows that Kueschler's corner is erroneous, therefore Kueschler's South line running from said corner is also incorrect, and the establishment of a new line from the new corner is required.

After the Commissioners decision had been rendered we again resumed our labors, and assisted by August Weinaum P. B. Love, Cha. Gehman & Ben - we commenced at a point on the westline of Kendall County herein before described, and running as far

1 north as we had run south, in running  
2 to and retracing the old line, we ran to a  
3 point 35966 varas due west from the S. E.  
4 Corner of Gillespie Co. and erected a stone-  
5 monument and marked same NE Cor. K. Co.





