

To the Honorable County Commissioners Court
of Gillespie County.

In obedience to order passed by your Honorable Body
by which I was appointed Special Surveyor to mark
and establish the boundaryline between Gillespie
and Kimble Counties - have the honor to report that
I have met Frank Vickrey the surveyor of Kimble County
and that we commenced work on the Countyline,
on the 28th day of August A.D. 1891. at a corner of Kerr
County, on the westline of Gillespie County, for S. E. cor.
ner of Kimble County, as heretofore made and estab-
lished by J. H. Davis surveyor of Kerr County and
myself, acting as Special Surveyor for Gillespie County
a stone monument marked S.E.K. from which a
Postoak 20' in dia: marked G bears N. 15° E. 44 varas
and a Postoak 14' in dia: marked G bears N. 14° E. 40⁷/₁₆
varas and a liveoak 20' in dia: marked K bears N.
83° W. 37⁷/₁₆ varas. Said Corner being 324 varas east
from the S. W. corner of Survey No 722 do S. E. cor. sur.
No 721 in name of G. C. & S. F. R. R. Co. Thence north at
1496 varas cross the southline of survey No 969. 26
& S. A. R. R. Co. 1323 varas west from a corner estab-
lished by State Surveyor G. M. Williams for S. E. Cor. of
said Sur. No 96 and described as follows: a stone
and from which a liveoak 8' in dia: bears N. 3¹/₄° E.
21 varas and a liveoak 18' in dia: bears S 28¹/₄° E.
48⁷/₁₆ varas and a liveoak 16' in dia: bears S. 88¹/₄°
E. 57¹/₂ varas, at 1679 varas cross the northline of
Sur. No 422 at a point 324 varas east from its N.
W. cor. and 877 varas west from its N. E. corner; at

varas. Thence north at 553 varas cross a road

in a draw of Pedernales; at 640 varas a dry branch; at 1250 varas cross another; at 1315 varas cross Fredericksburg and Junction City road; at 1355 varas a liveoak 16' in dia; marked I C L; at 1506 varas cross northline Sur. N^o 96 & S. A. R. R. Co. 1323 varas west from a corner established by State Surveyor G. M. Williams for N. E. cor. said sur. N^o 96 and described as follows: a stoneid. from which a S. O. 16' in dia; brs S. 84° W. 125 $\frac{4}{5}$ and a S. O. 3' in dia; brs S. 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 9 $\frac{2}{5}$ varas; at 1849 varas a point from which the N. W. cor. of sur. N^o 977 bears east 910 varas; at 1900 var. a stone monument marked 2. M. S. E. K. from which a liveoak 14' in dia; marked G bears S. 36° E. 58 varas a liveoak 14' in dia; marked G brs S. 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 50 varas a liveoak 16' in dia; marked K bears S. 38° W. 49 varas. —

Thence north at 515 cross a road; at 538 cross a fence; at 990 cross a fence; at 1510 varas cross the northline of Survey N^o 95 do southline N^o 92 as established by State Surveyor G. M. Williams 577 varas east from the N. W. corner of survey N^o 95 do S. W. cor. Sur. N^o 92 described as follows: a liveoak 18' in dia; brs N. 43° W. 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas do 9' in dia; brs N. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 104 varas; at 1900 varas a stone monument marked 3 M. S. E. K. from which a liveoak 16' marked K bears S. 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 38 $\frac{1}{4}$ varas and a liveoak 16' in dia; marked G bears S. 39° W. 35 varas. —

Thence north cross divide between Pedernales and Falls Creek; at 1900 varas a stone monument marked 4 M. S. E. K. from which a liveoak 8' in dia; marked G bears N. 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 98 varas and a liveoak 14' in dia; marked K bears S. 87° W. 49 varas. —

Thence north at 660 varas cross a draw of Falls Creek; at 1050 varas cross a draw of Falls Creek at 1390 varas cross a draw of Falls Creek, at 1512

varas cross the northline of Survey N^o 49 G. H. & S. A. R. R. Co. 510 varas east from the N. W. corner of said Survey as established by G. M. Williams at 1820 cross a draw of Falls Creek; at 1900 varas a stonem^oument marked 5 M.S.E.K. from which a Black Jack 12' in dia; marked G bears N. 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E 66 varas and a liveoak 16' in dia; marked K br. S. 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 82 varas. —

Thence north running on eastern slope of mountain, at 130 varas cross a draw of Falls Creek; at 1550 varas cross a draw of Falls Creek at 1880 varas an old stonem^oument at 1900 varas a stone monument marked 6. M.S.E.K from which a liveoak 5' in dia; marked G bears N. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ varas and a liveoak 8' in dia; marked K bears S. 14° W. 52 $\frac{4}{5}$ Thence north at 190 varas cross a large draw, thence run on western slope of mountain, at 630 varas cross a draw; at 1200 varas cross a draw; at 1480 varas cross a draw at 1640 varas cross the southline of Survey N^o 631 S. A. & M. G. R. R. Co. 468 varas west from the S. E. corner of said Survey N^o 631 do S. W. cor. of sur. N^o 630 from which a liveoak 8' bears S. 30° W. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas and a liveoak 14' in dia; bears S. 20 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E. 27 varas; at 1780 varas a draw; at 1900 varas a stonem^oument marked 7 M.S.E.K. from which a liveoak 12' in dia; marked G bears N. 21 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° E. 22 $\frac{2}{5}$ varas and a liveoak 10' in dia; marked K bears S. 31 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 38 $\frac{2}{5}$ varas Thence north at 485 varas cross a draw; at 1195 varas cross the northline Sur. N^o 631 do S. l. Sur. N^o 628 S. A. & M. G. R. R. Co. 475 varas west from N. E. cor. sur. N^o 631 do S. E. cor. N^o 628 at 1500 varas a high bluff on southside of Fall Creek; at 1720 varas a high bluff on northside of Fall Creek; at 1900 varas a stone monument marked 8 M.S.E.K. from which a liveoak 8' in dia; marked K bears S. 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 20 $\frac{4}{5}$ a liveoak 12' in dia; marked G bears S. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 57 varas

Thence north cross ravine, run along eastside of Fall Creek crossing and recrossing bluffs, at 450 varas cross S. l. N. 49 S. M & S do northline of survey N. 628 S. A. & M. G. R. R. Co 482 varas west from its N. E. cor. do N. W. cor. sur. N. 629 from which a live oak 7' in dia; br. N. 3° W. 7 varas and a live oak stump bears N. 45³/₄° E. 22¹/₄ varas; at 1585 cross N. l. N. 49 do S. l. N. 125 at 1900 varas a stone monument marked 9 M. S. E. K. from which a live oak 8' in dia; marked G br. S. 35° E. 18³/₅ varas and a live oak 10' in dia; marked K bears S. 15¹/₂° W. 26¹/₂ varas. —

Thence north at 620 varas branch 760 varas branch at 830 varas point 8 varas east of Rayners house; at 1900 stone monument in a chin oak thicket, marked 10 M. S. E. K.

Thence north at 551 varas cross the northline of survey N. 125 in name of Orpa Warren do southline survey N. 12. 400 varas west from the S. E. corner of said survey N. 12 at 1560 varas divide between Fall Creek & Salt Creek at 1900 varas a stone monument marked 11 M. S. E. K. in a draw of salt Creek from which a live oak 12' br. S. 27° W. 6³/₅ varas marked G and a live oak 12' in dia; marked K bears N. 49° W. 9 varas. —

Thence north at 875 varas cross the northline of survey N. 12 do S. l. N. 10 at a point from which the N. E. cor. N. 12 do S. E. corner N. 10 to wit: a stone md. from which a spanish oak 24' in dia; br. S. 40° W. 127 varas, bears east 400 varas at 890 varas crosses a branch; at 1410 varas cross a branch at 1900 varas a stone monument marked 12 M. S. E. K. from which a live oak marked K bears S. 8¹/₂° W. 31 varas. — Thence north at 430 branch at 480 varas branch at 1100 varas branch at 1329 varas the northline survey N. 10 and a wire fence, at a point

from which the N. E. corner of survey No. 10 do S. E. survey
No. 8 bears East 400 varas; said corner being
described as follows; L. O. 5 S. 40 W. 2. L. O. 12 S. 35
E. 28 no. at 1900 varas stone monument marked 13
M. S. E. K. —

Thence north at 1118 varas cross
S. E. survey No. 688 in name of Francisca Ruiz 146 varas
east of its S. W. Corner; at 1900 varas a stone monu-
ment on a mountain marked 14 M. S. E. K. —

Thence north at 1280 varas top of a high mountain;
at 1520 varas a stone monument bears west 146 varas and
from this a live oak 8' in dia; old mark $\frac{5}{16}$ bro. N. 13'
W. 36 varas; at 1900 varas a stone monument in
a valley marked 15 M. S. E. K. from which a stone
monument on a high mountain bears N. 84' W. —

Thence north at 230 varas cross old Ft. Terret road,
at 559 varas a stone monument in prairie for
N. W. corner of Gillespie County and N. E. corner of
Kinble County marked NW G & NE K from which
corner of Gillespie County heretofore made by Kuebler
bears East 6 varas and a stone monument on
a high mountain bro. S. 39 1/4' W. and a Mesquite 12'
in dia; old mark $\frac{5}{16}$ bro. S. 47 1/2' W. 55 varas and
a Mesquite 12' in dia; new mark $\frac{5}{16}$ bro. S. 52' E.
30 5/8 varas. Bearings marked $\frac{5}{16}$ or K.

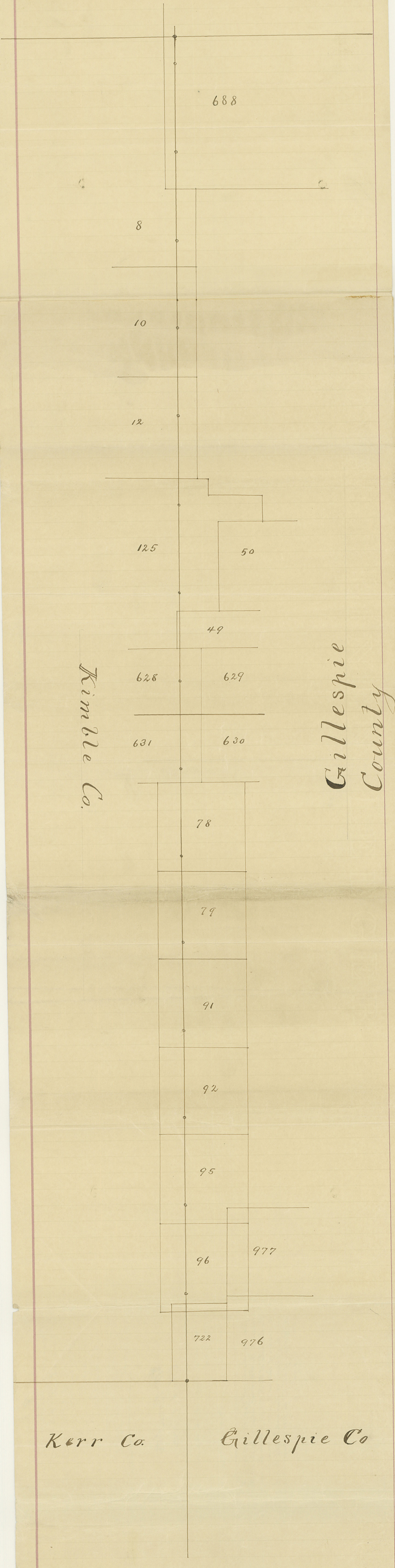
