Field Notes of a survey of the North Boundary
 Line of Glasscock County, made by virtue of an
 order of the County Commissioners of Glasscock
 & Sterling Counties.

Beginning at a large sand stone pier
 about five feet long set in the ground by surveyor
 Estes for the North East corner of Midland County
 said stone is marked M.C. N.E. Cor on the top surface
 & N.W. C. & Co on East face, a set stone in a stone
 mound, mhd. 1. M.S. hrs south. 1900.8 vars.

1st mile x Thence East at 950 vars cross the Stanton & Gordon
 City road. 1900.8 vars to a stone monument
 between two pits in open prairie.

2nd mile x Thence East crossing a fence 1900.8 vars to a stone
 monument in sand hills in shivery brush.

3rd mile x Thence East at 585 vars cross a fence and 1900.8 vars
 a stone monument in firm cat claw flat from
 which point of mountain hrs N. 58° 20' East. point
 of hills hrs N. 17° 30' west.

4th mile x Thence East at 1127⁵/₁₀ vars cross fence course S.
 23° 45' East at 1900.8 vars a mound of Earth & stone
 between two pits.

5th mile x Thence East 1900.8 vars a mound of Earth & stone
 and four pits at the N.W. end of Lake.

6" x Thence East passing over a ridge 1900.8 varas to
Earth mound and (4) four pits in firm mesquite shrubby
flat.

7" x Thence East at 287.3 Varas cross fence at 1900.8 varas a
large earth mound in circular trench from
which a pile of stones West 13. Varas. a mesquite
tree brs S. 10° 30' W. 21.2 Varas.

8" x Thence East 1900.8 Varas to a stone monument and (4)
four pits in a block sand flat from which a
mesquite tree brs N. 31° 30' E 142.5 Varas.

9" x Thence East 1900.8 Varas stone monument and (4)
four pits from which a mesquite tree brs S.
12° 15' W. 13.8 Varas. another mesquite tree brs
N. 33° 30' E 38.2 Varas.

10" x Thence East crossing a fence and at 1900.8 varas stone
monument and (4) pits from which a mound
one brs S. 32° 30' west. The west point of the range
of Big Springs mountains brs N. 41° 20' East.

11" x Thence East 1900.8 varas to a large stone set in
ground and marked 19. W. from which a mesquite tree
brs S. 15° 20' W. 44. Varas.

12" x Thence East 1900.8 varas to a pile of stone in W. P. Edwards
field.

13" x Thence East passing out of farm and crossing Mustang
Craw. and at 1900.8 varas to a stone set in ground on the west
slope and marked 17. W.

14" x Thence East passing over hill at 1390.6. Varas. cross
mile fence at 1512. Varas. pass about 36 Varas. North of South end.
windmill at 1900.8 Varas. to a large north mound in
firm flat from which a windmill bears S. 78° 15'
west. Windmill bears S. 4° 45' East

15" x Thence East 1900.8 Varas to stone set in the ground
mile x marked 15. W. in small piece of stone from which
x a windmill bears S. 52° 30' W.

16" x Thence East 1900.8 Varas stone set in the ground
mile x marked 14. W.

17" x Thence East at 1476. Varas cross the Garden City
mile x & Big Springs Road. 1900.8 Varas. to a flat stone
x set in ground between two pits. marked 13. W.
x from which a Windmill bears S 46° 30' W. another
x Windmill bears S. 4° 15' E

18" x Thence East 1900.8 Varas. set stone marked 12. W.
mile x in stone mound. from which a windmill bears S.
x 39° 50' W. another Windmill bears S. 25° 30' W.

19" x Thence East passing over rocky ridge 1900.8
mile x Varas. set stone marked 11. W. in mound of stone in
x small valley.

20" x Thence East passing over a rocky ridge at 1309.3.
mile x Varas. cross a drain course. South end at 1682.8 Varas.
x passing 3/4 Varas. North of an old stone mound. One
x large stone marked N. W. V. III on west slope of hill
x 1900.8 Varas. to a large stone set in stone mound

10. W. from which a windmill in draw brs. S.
57° 20' N. another windmill at John Phillips
brs S. 5° 50' E.

21
mile * Thence East passing over hill and descending slope
at 1230.1 vrs. cross. Road at Forks, and at 1780.2
vrs. cross branch at 1900.8 vrs. to a stone
set in ground. marked N. W. from which a
Windmill at Mill Curries Ranch brs. 26° 30' E
another windmill at Bur Settles Ranch N.
36° 30' W.

mile * Thence East passing across the valley at 1656.
vrs. cross a branch. course south. and descending
slope. 1900.8 vrs. set stone in mound. marked
S. W. from which a mesquite tree brs. 27° 30'
N. 22.3 vrs.

23
mile * Thence East ascending slope and passing over
ridge at 1823.4 vrs cross branch. at 1864.8 vrs.
cross Road in branch. 1900.8 vrs. stone mound.
3 vrs. south of bank of branch. a pit south 3 1/2
vrs. and East mound. at south end of pit. a mesquite
tree brs N. 88° 10' E. 150.2 vrs. a windmill at Mill
Curries Ranch brs S 10° 10' W.

24
mile * Thence East at 27.3 vrs. 68. vrs 117. vrs and 231.5 vrs.
crossing and recrossing branch. at 1900.8 vrs to
stone set in stone mound. marked 6. W.

25" mile Thence East at 378.0 vs cross settles East fence and cross drain below dam at 612 vs. cross or pass Rock slip rapped dam at The North end at 1900.8 vs set stone in stone mound. Marked 5 M. from which a mesquite tree brs S 71° 45' E 41.7 vs. a windmill br N. 3° 30' W.

26" mile Thence East descending slope at 925.2 vs. cross drain course S.E. and at 1315 vs. cross drain course S.W. at 1443.6 vs cross. Wagon road 1900.8 vs set stone in stone mound, on west slope of a rocky hill stone marked 4 M. from which a mesquite tree brs S. 85° 45' W. 9 vs a windmill br. N. 56° 50' W.

27" mile Thence East 1900.8 vs. to flat stone set in stone mound. Marked 3 M. from which a windmill at Sanders and Ranch brs N. 83° 40' E a clump of Hackberry trees on top of round hill about midway of same br N. 3° 35' W.

28" mile Thence East 1900.8 vs. to a stone set in stone mound marked 2 M. from which a stone mound brs S. 4° 45' W. 15.8 vs. a windmill at Sanders and Ranch br N. 14° 40' W. a set stone at the S.E. cor of sec no 13. N 4 N. W. Ry. Co as placed by State Surveyor. G. M. Williams and marked S.E. cor. 13. brs. N. 58° 25' E 50.2. 2 vs.

29" mile Thence East at 63 vs. cross branch course S.E. at 327 vs pass fence crossing a road. course S.E. 1900.8 vs. to a stone set in stone mound. Marked 1 M. from which a mesquite tree brs. S. 45° 45' E 22.5 vs. a mesquite tree brs N. 63° 45' E 63.9 vs.

30" Thence East crossing a fence and passing
 mile over a rocky ridge and, crossing a square
 drain 1900.8 rods. to a large stone monument
 (3) Three feet high ²⁰(3) Three feet at the base with
 (2) two large flat stones set in same and a
 red flat stone facing southwest marked N E
 cor. A. C. and the other a large flat lime stone
 facing South East, and marked. N. N. cor B C
 from which a large stone monument (3)
 feet high on east side of a square canyon bearing
 S. 84° 45' E 112.7 rods, another stone monument
 (3) feet high on the south brink of canyon
 bearing S 42° 30' E 203.4 rods. a mound in
 the Valley bearing N. 86° E
