I am in receipt of a copy of the report of W. D. Twichell, surveyor, who run the above line in the year, 1906, a report of which was made to your office. The copy of this report that was made to Gray County has been misplaced and it cannot be found. It was filed in your office on the 16th day of May, 1906, but I do not believe your records show that it has been formally approved.

The local commissioners: court has investigated this matter and is satisfied with the location of the line as made by Mr. Twichell and in accordance with the enclosed certified copy of a resolution herewith enclosed is requested that you formally approve this report. I am requesting that you send me a certified copy of this approving certificate so that it may be copied in the minutes of my court.

This approval is requested so that the matter may be settled for the future and that no controversy may arise. In the year, 1906, the Commissioner changed the abstract records and instructed the assessors of Gray and Roberts Counties to correct and change the acreage shown in each section affected.

May 25, 1934 Mr. Sherman White, County Attorney, Pampa, Texas Dear Sir: I have your letter of May 14th enclosing certified copy of resolution or order of the Commissioners' Court of Gray County in reference to the boundary matter along the North line of Gray county. You refer to the W D Twichell survey of this line in 1906, report of which was filed with this department May 16, 1906. It appears that the copy which should have been filed in the clerk's office of Gray county, has been misplaced or lost, and that the Commissioners' court of that county have been investigating the matter, and now being satisfied with the location of the Twichell line, desire approval by this department of the Twichell survey in accordance with copy of resolution which you enclosed. There is nothing in the way of an endorsement on the Twichell report to show that it has been approved, altho in effect, this would seem to be the case, since the abstract was corrected in accordance with that report. The report does not show that it was accepted and approved by order of the county courts of the two counties, as the law provides, or that copies were filed in the clerk's offices of those counties. It would seem from Mr Twichell's letter with the report and a part thereof, that he was notified by Coffee & Kelley, Attorneysometresenting Roberts county, that Roberts and Hutchinson counties would not send a surveyor and that these counties would accept the boundaries as established by him. I presume under these circumstances, that the line as marked by Mr Twichell was in effect, accepted by both counties. Counter 53909

Sherman White -2-Before I would be willing to mark these field notes approved at this late date, I believe that Gray and Roberts counties should each submit to this department a certified copy of the order from the Minutes of the County Courts of those counties going to show that they accept and recognize as correct the boundaries as established by Mr Tiwchell. In these matters this department should be guided by the statute affecting county lines, which will be found in Atticle 1582 et seq., Chapter 4 Revised Civil Statutes of 1925.
