

Counties of Grayson & Fannin

To the Hon. D. D. Steedman, Judge of the County Court of Grayson County



The undersigned, Ordered by  
the judges of the respective counties aforesaid,  
to survey out and establish the boundary  
line between said counties, beg leave to re-  
port, that we have completed the same in per-  
suance of said order, and submit the follow-  
ing as our report, together with the accompan-  
ying sketch map, of the same and Survey con-  
tiguous to said line which is made a part of  
our report.

Beginning on the South bank of Red River, at  
the mouth of Choctaw Bayou. Planted Post a  
Bois d'arc post 50 Varas South of the bank of  
Red River 8 inches in diameter, marked on  
the East side NW cor FC, and on the West side NE  
cor GC, from which an Elm marked GC, brs  
S. 71° W 2 $\frac{3}{4}$  vars. and a bois d'arc tree Mkd FC brs S 24°  
E - Thence South on a magnetic variation off  
East, at 1205 varas cross the East line of the John Deck  
Survey, at 1450 varas a lake, at 1850 varas planted  
post marked L.M.

2 South on the second mile, at 155 Varas, cross  
the N line of the B. J. Fitch Survey, 1851 Varas N 84° E  
from said Fitch's N.W cor, at 955 varas cross the South

line of said Fitch and the North line of Daniel Mon-  
tague 13 var. N 85° E from their corners on the West.  
continuing South at 1220 varas a branch. course South  
East - at 1900 varas set a post. Mhd 2 M.

3. Thence South on the third mile at 410 varas. cross  
the Pecan branch. course South East. at 1900 Varas.  
set a post. Mhd 3 M.
4. South on the 4th mile at 85 varas cross the South  
line of Jesse Wallace Survey 1188 varas East of Mon-  
tague S.W. cor. and 1688 varas West from their E.E.  
corner. Con. South at 1842 varas. branch C-East.  
at 1900 varas set a post Mhd 4 M.
5. Thence South on the 5th mile at 620. vars a branch  
C-East. at 1069 varas cross the South line of said Wal-  
lace. and North line of Charles Daugherty 298 varas from  
said Wallace's SW cor. and 2522 varas from his SE cor. and 838 varas  
from said Daugherty's NW cor. Con. South at 1900. 8 varas set  
post Mhd 5 M. in field on the East side of small drain.
6. South on 6th mile. at 813 varas cross the South line of said  
Daugherty and North line of H.C. Briants Survey 667 varas from  
said Daugherty's NW cor. 838 varas from said Briants NW cor.  
South at 1780 Varas a branch C. South East at 1900. 8  
varas set post in brushy timber Mhd 6 M. on the N. bank of  
a small branch.
7. South on 7th mile at 55 varas. Brushy Creek. course  
S.E. at 263 varas. cross the South line of said Briants  
and the North line of John Weeks Survey 703 varas.

N 82 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. from their corner - Con. South at 1140 was  
Davy road - c. S.E. at 1360 was a branch. C. S.E. at  
1900.8 was set post Mkd 7 M. in field about 40' N.W. of  
branch C. N.E.

8. South on the 8<sup>th</sup> Mile at 1735 was cross the Texas and  
Pacific Railroad. at 1900.8 was set post Mkd 8 M. in  
prairie
9. South on 9<sup>th</sup> Mile at 100 was cross branch. C. East  
at 820 was to a point West of Davy about one half  
+ mile. at 1000 was the S. line of said Weeks Survey and  
the N. line of H.J. Journey. 804 was East of said Weeks W.  
cor. and 504 was East from said Journey's NW cor. Con-  
South at 1820 was. Davy Creek. Course East. at 1900.8  
was. Set post Mkd 9 M. 10 was West of Browders Tank.
- + 10. South on 10<sup>th</sup> Mile at 33 was. Cross the South line of said  
journey. and N. line of C. Daniel. Survey 521 was. East  
from his SW cor. (Journey) at 1900.8 was. Set post Mkd 10 M.  
in Browders field.
11. Thence South on the 11<sup>th</sup> Mile at 1609 was. Cross the South  
X line of said Daniel Survey. and the boundary line of  
University League No 2 - 1050 was East from said Dan-  
iel's SW cor. Continuing South between the University  
lands of Grapow and Fannin Counties. at 1900.8 —  
set post marked 11 M. in Hortons field.
12. South on 12<sup>th</sup> Mile. at 1720. was to center of Judge  
A.M. Bryant's house. at 1900.8 was set post Mkd 12 M.  
in his field
13. South on 13<sup>th</sup> Mile. at 1900.8 was. Set post Mkd

13. M. in prairie

14. South on 15<sup>th</sup> Mile, at 940 was cross the Kentucky-Town & Bonham road, at 1145. varas to Bois d'arc Creek. Course. East, at 1400 was cross the S line of the W H Anderson Survey, 760 varas East from his N W corner. Con-South at 1900.8 varas set post in field. MK'd 14.M.
- X 15. South on 15<sup>th</sup> Mile, at 700 varas pass a point East of Whitewright, 1180 varas to Mathews house, at 1730 varas branch Course South East, at 1900.8 varas set post MK'd 15.M. about 80 varas West of the Deans Chapel.
16. South on the 16<sup>th</sup> Mile at 500. varas. Cross the S line of said Anderson Survey, and N. boundary line of the University lands of Tarrant and Grayson Counties, 860 varas East from said Anderson's South West corner. Continuing South at 1900.8 varas set post MK'd 16.M.
17. South on 17<sup>th</sup> Mile, at 1900.8 varas set post MK'd 17.M. in a road.
18. South on the 18<sup>th</sup> Mile at 370 varas cross the Mo Pacific Railroad, at 1900.8 varas set post MK'd 18.M.
19. South on the 19<sup>th</sup> Mile at 1900.8 varas set post MK'd 19.M. in thicket.
20. South on the 20<sup>th</sup> Mile, at 1900.8 varas set post MK'd 20.M.
21. South on 21<sup>st</sup> Mile at 630 varas a branch C. West, at 1600 varas to a branch, C. South West, at 1800 varas to a small drain, at 1900.8 varas set post MK'd 21.M. in prairie.

22. South on the 22<sup>nd</sup> mile at 280 was. branch C.  
West at 1900.8 was set post M&G 22M.
23. South on the 23<sup>rd</sup> mile at 380 varas to the S.E. cor-  
ner of Grayson County set Post M&G S.E. Cor. G.C. on the  
North side and F.C. on East side and N.E. Cor. C.C. on South  
side. The bearing of this corner is down. It is identified  
by bearing original and M&G line running West & North.  
All posts M&G C on W. side & F.C. on East side, thus  
completing said line

We also certify that the posts as set on said line are  
such as are required by law, and are of bois d'arc  
timber, and are all marked on the East side with F.C.  $\frac{3}{4}$
