Attention was called to two letters published in the Upstun County Democrat addressed to Hon J J Lowe County Judge of Upstun County one from yourself the other from Mr Rhodes Justice in the last one, it states the field notes of the Survey between Gregg and Upstun Counties have been received and adopted and on the Maps changed accordingly

I beg to call your attention to the 2<sup>d</sup> Sec of the act Creating the County of Gregg - in General Laws of 1873 in which you will see the act required the Commissioners appointed by the Legislature to organize the County

to employ a Competent Surveyor  
to run the lines and a Copy of the  
field notes of said Survey to be  
recorded in the District Clerk's Office  
of Gregg County and a Copy filed  
in the Office of the Secretary of State  
The Law was strictly Complied  
with and Mr A B Taylor was  
Employed to make the Survey  
(Upshur County refusing to assist  
him in making it) It would have  
been more appropriate to have  
the field notes filed in your Office  
but the Law required otherwise  
We have been exercising jurisdiction  
in accordance with Taylors Survey  
from the time it was made to the  
present and was surprised when  
I saw the Ordinance that the Maps  
had been changed to suit a later  
Survey by Mr Glasco made without  
authority in Law, I have requested  
the Secretary of State to file a Certified  
Copy of Taylors Survey in your Office  
& request your authority <sup>in the claim</sup>
