Consolidated field notes
of a survey of Gregg County made by vir-
tue of an act entitled An act to create and
provide for the organization of the County of
Gregg passed April 12th 1873, also by virtue of
An act entitled An act to extend the area and
enlarge the County of Gregg approved April 30th
1874. Said County is situated and described
as follows, to wit: Beginning at the SW corner
of Harrison County a stake on N Bank of the
Sabine River from which a Birch 18 inches in
diameter bears N 14° E 50ms marked H C, another
Birch 20 inches in diameter bears S 56° W $9\frac{7}{10}$ ms marked
W C. Thence North with W line of Harrison County
to little Cypress a large white oak for corner, thence
up Cypress with its meanderings to the mouth of
Glade Creek, thence up said creek with its
meanderings to its intersection with the north Marshall
and Gilmer Road thence S 30° W $2\frac{5}{10}$ miles to Omega
on South Marshall and Gilmer Road. Thence S $56\frac{1}{2}$ W
 $5\frac{7}{10}$ miles to a point 12 miles S 35° E from the town of Gil-
mer. Thence S 63° W 9 miles to the NE corner of Smith
County on south bank of Sabine River. Thence South
with East line of Smith County to the SW corner of
the George Melton Survey a stake from which

an Elm bears S 35° E 2 1/2 rods marked Rb. a Gum
bears N 50° E 13 1/2 rods marked Gb. Thence East to a point
due North from Henderson 15 miles continuing east to
the intersection of Cherokee Bayou with the Camden
and Henderson Road, a black Gum at north end
of the Bridge for corner marked Gb. Thence N 20° E to
the centre of the town of Camden a stake on bank
of Sabine River, from which a white Oak bears S 55°
W 8 rods marked Gb. a Pine bears N 55° E 6 rods marked Rb.
Thence up said River with its meanderings to the place
of beginning containing 300 Square miles more or less.
