of Gregg County, made by virtue of an Act  
entitled "An Act to create and provide for  
the organization of the County of Gregg" passed  
April 12<sup>th</sup> 1873. Said County is situated and  
described as follows to wit: Beginning at the  
S W corner of Harrison, and S E corner of Upshur  
Counties, a stake on N bank of Sabine River  
from which a Birch 18 inches in diameter has  
bears N 14° E, 5000 marked H C, another Birch  
20 in, in diameter bears S 56° W. 9 1/2 000, marked W C.  
Thence north with west line of Harrison County  
18 miles to the intersection of said line with Little  
Cypress a large white Oak blazed for a corner.  
Thence with the meanderings of Cypress and  
Glade Creek N 50° W. 37/100 miles S 65° W. 37/100 miles  
N 50° W. 16/100 miles N 80° W. 53/100 miles to the intersection  
of said Creek with the north Marshall and Gilmer  
road Thence S 30° W. 2/10 miles to Omega on south  
Marshall and Gilmer road, Thence S 56 1/2° W. 5 1/10  
miles to a point 12 miles S 35° E from the town of  
Gilmer Thence S 63° W. 9 miles to the N W corner  
of Cook and N E corner of Smith Counties on  
Sabine River Thence with the meanderings of  
said river to the beginning containing 200



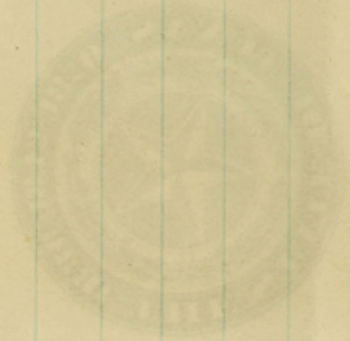
