Agreement between A.S. Taylor County  
Surveyor for Gregg County and J.M. Glasco  
County Surveyor for Upshur county

We the undersigned being appointed as a  
commission to settle upon and survey the  
line between Upshur & Gregg county  
Agree as follows. Beginning at the  
court house and running  $S37^{\circ}E$  12 miles  
Then begin at the the middle of Glade or Prairie  
creek where Northern Marshall & Gilmer road  
crosses the same (this is recognised as one of the  
initial points) Thence running to the 12  
mile post Thence to the N.W. corner  
of Rusk & the N.E. corner of Smith county on  
the south bank of the Sabine River.

And we further agree that if in surveying  
said line, we should fail to close at the  
point designated, then if it comes within  
of closing as laid down by the General Land  
office then the line so run shall be the line  
and further upon running the first line  
the 12 mile post was missed 70 rods  $S37^{\circ}E$ , this  
is recognised as the true corner and is so given  
in the field notes, and the second line  
was run to the Sabine River intersecting  
the same at a point 50 rods East from the  
Geo. W. Hamptons survey. we agree that the  
Sabine River shall be the line to the corner



of Rusk & Smith county and is to be  
the establishe line between Upshur & Gregg  
county
