Field-notes of County line between
Rusk and Gregg Counties:

Beginning at the S.W. corner
of the George Melton survey on the
east line of Smith County

Due west from a stake 15 miles
north from the center of the Courthouse
in the town of Henderson, Rusk County
Texas a stake from which a survey
runs bears S. 35° E 8 feet marked
R. C. a survey runs N. 50°
E 39 feet marked G. C. an elm
runs west 10 feet marked S. C.

Thence east with the south line
of the George Melton survey, the south
line of the M. Coleman survey also
east with the south line of the two
M. H. Johnson surveys ^{thence} east through
the W. P. Whisman survey 3000 vrs
N. of the S.W. corner of same con-
tinuing east through the J. S. Ca-
uthers survey 1160 vrs North of
south line of same. Thence east
through the Mary Vanwinkle sur-
vey 690 vrs N. of S. line of same
thence east through the Henry
Wells survey 1210 vrs. S. of the N.
line of same thence east through
the H. Edwards survey 964 vrs N.

 F. Thorn survey at N. W. corner
 of the J. N. Malsie survey on the
 east line of the H. Hoover survey
 thence east through the Thorn
 survey striking the John Matthews
 survey 4560 Vrs N 10° E from S.
 N. corner of the same. thence
 east through the Mathews survey
 striking the F. Castro survey 5000
 Vrs. S 10° N from the Sabine river.
 thence east to Cherokee Bayou in
 the Castro survey thence with the
 meanderings of said Bayou which
 general course is east through the
 said Castro survey striking the
 D. Simpson survey west line
 5000 Vrs. south 10° N. from Sabine
 River thence with said Bayou
 through the Simpson survey strik-
 ing the west line of the Isaac
 Lee survey. 3965 Vrs. S. 10° N from
 Sabine River, thence east with the
 meanderings of said Bayou through
 the Isaac Lee survey striking the

John Walling Survey 6008 Vrs, N10^o
E. from the South West corner of
same thence east with the mean-
derings of said Bayou 1250 Vrs.
to the Bridge on the Camden and
Henderson public road on the John
Walling League, thence N20^oE
4000 Vrs to a stake on the bank
of Sabine River the town of Cam-
den 700 Vrs west of the N.E. corner
of the John Walling League survey a
white oak bears S 55 W 8 Vrs mark-
ed S.C. a pine bears N 55 E
6 Vrs marked R.C.
