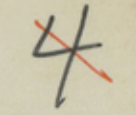


I, Will. P. Hedgecocke County Surveyor of Hall Co Texas and also

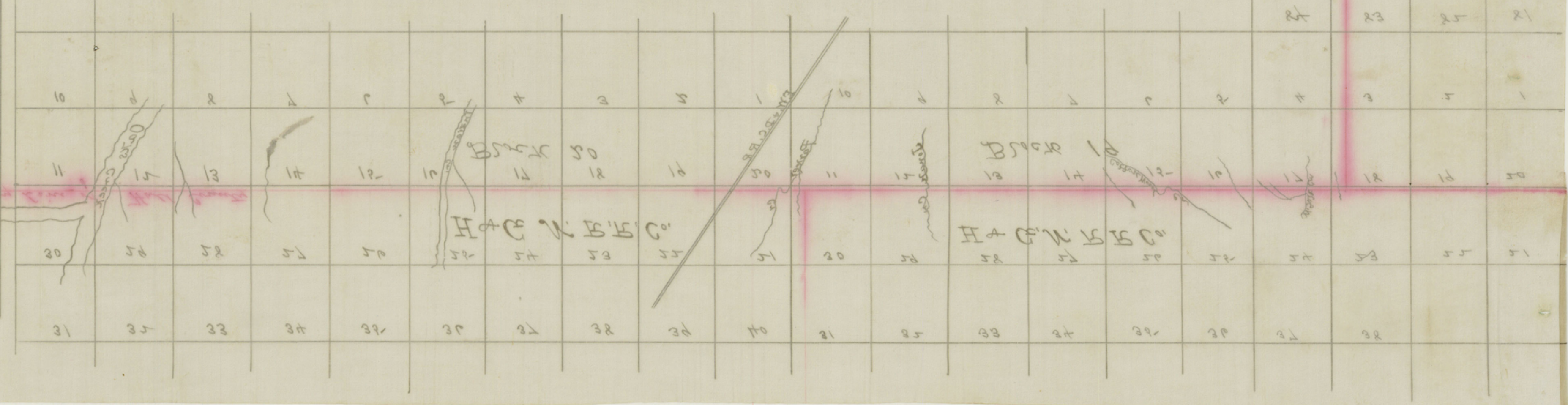
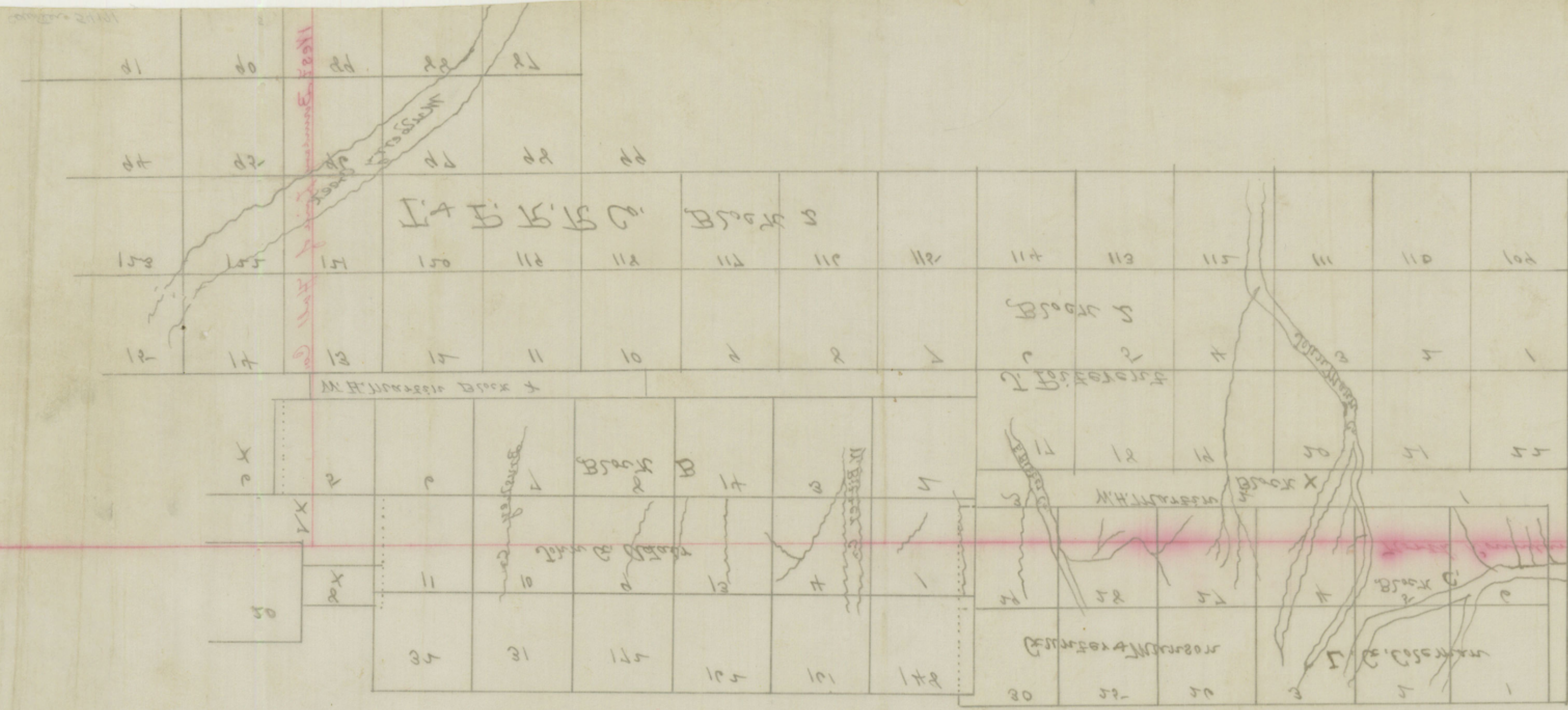
