Hamilton County -

In accordance with
an order issued from your Court
May 22 1879 directing me in
conjunction with the County
Surveyor of Bosque County to
Establish the East boundary line
of this County by commencing
at the Brazos River & measuring
S 60 W 25 ~~to~~ miles for the
N W Corner of Bosque & the N E
Corner of Hamilton. I beg leave
to submit the following report
accompanied with plat & field
notes - to which your attention
is called - In company with
the County Surveyors of Bosque
& Sumner Counties. I began
the Survey on the Banks of the
Brazos at the N E Corner of the
N B Wilson League. which is
also the N E Corner of Bosque Co
County - Running thence S 60 W
25 miles We established the
N W Corner of Bosque in the

Wm M Smith Survey of 8¹/₂ Leagues
570 ns Sec W from the E line of
same & 520 ns - N 30 W from
the South line of said Smith -
The survey was carefully made
and monuments as prescribed by
Law were placed at the initial
corners and at every mile on
the line run & the ~~lines~~ ^{lines} of all
surveys through which the County
line passed were accurately
noted - besides all natural
prominent objects such as
branches Creeks & Rivers were
given - The field notes & plots
accompanying this report will
fully explain the position of the
East boundary line of this
County as established by the
County Surveyor of Bosque
& myself -
