Survey of part of the County line between the Counties of Austin and Montgomery agreeable to an order of the Honorable John P Borden Commis- Genl. of the Land office. and having made the necessary arrangements with the County Surveyor of the County of Austin together with a Deputy of said County by the Name of James C. Blair Beginning at the head of Spring Creek made a corner on a Black oak 20 inches diam. marked \bar{x} from which a Black oak 20 in. dia. bears $N 57^{\circ} W$ marked \bar{z} 10 varas dist. and a pine oak 12 in. dia. marked \bar{y} bears $N 79^{\circ} W$ 22² 10 varas dist. Thence $S 81^{\circ} W$

8046 varas to the head of Bond Creek on the North Bank a Black oak 10 in. dia. marked \bar{x} from which a post 16 in. dia. marked \bar{z} bears $N 26^{\circ} 30' W$ 16 varas and a Black oak 10 in. dia. marked \bar{y} bears $N 58^{\circ} E$ 7² 10 varas dist.
