And I do hereby fully authorize and empower, my said attorney to sign, seal, and deliver any receipt, bond, or other document necessary to procure the said moneys from the Com^r or other departments &c as aforesaid, or any other person, or persons legally authorized to deliver the same; and generally to do & perform all and singular, my acts or acts, necessary and proper to procure said money. All of which acts I bind myself, heirs, &c to ratify and confirm, as fully as if I myself had done the same personally.
