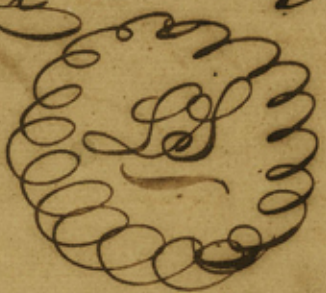
County of Montgomery } I know all men by these pres-  
ents that S. John Wade, of the Republic and County  
aforesaid do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint  
Andrew Harper of the Republic and County afore-  
said my true and lawful attorney to apply for, and  
in my name to receive from the proper authorities  
the amount due me as my share of the fees for  
running the division line between the Counties of  
Montgomery and Harris - as already returned to the  
Commissioners of the General Land Office, and I  
hereby authorize the aforesaid Andrew Harper to  
receive any and all monies that may be due  
for the same, and receipt for said money - hereby  
ratifying and confirming all his acts necessary  
in said business, as fully as if performed by me;
