It is ordered by the Court that the report of E. J. Flynt Surveyor appointed by this Court to survey the West boundary line of Hardeman County be and the same is hereby in all things confirmed and said line as designated in said report shall hereafter be the West Boundary Line of Hardeman County be and the same is hereby in all things confirmed and said line as designated in said report shall hereafter be the West Boundary Line of said County. Said report is as follows. to wit:

To the Hon Commissioners Court of Hardeman Co,
I E. J. Flynt Surveyor duly appointed by your Hon Court to lay off Survey mark and designate part of the West line of Hardeman County the same being the E. B. line of Childress County did in conjunction with T. L. Crews a Surveyor duly appointed by the Commissioners Court of Childress County for the same purpose did from the 28th day of August to the 19th day of September A.D. 1892 Survey mark and designate on the ground part of the West line of Hardeman County the same being the East line of Childress County the field notes of which line are hereto attached together with a Map thereof E. J. Flynt Surveyor.

Field notes of a Survey as ordered by the Commissioners Court of Childress and Hardeman Counties for the Establishment of the East line of said Childress County and that part of the West Boundary line of Hardeman County by T. L. Crews duly appointed and qualified by the Commissioners Court of said Childress County and E. J. Flynt duly appointed and qualified by the said Commissioners Court of said Hardeman County.

Beginning at the North West Corner of Baylor County and the South West Corner of Willbarger County a Sand Stone set in the earth 3x3 in a valley of South Beaver Creek and marked {K} and {NW} on the South Side

and H/W on the North Side from which a Hackberry tree bears North $25^{\circ}45'$ E. 138 varas. Another bears North $21^{\circ}30'$ E. 131 varas (neither one marked) a Red Sandstone marked A on a natural Red Round Mound bears South $57^{\circ}45'$ West 112 varas. dist. Thence North at fifteen miles and 1850 varas reach the South Bank of Pease River Course N 30° E. at twenty eight miles and 1416 varas cross the Fort Worth and Denver City Rail Road Course North $77^{\circ}13'$ West Continuing North at thirty one miles and 240 varas. in all reach a point 50 varas South of Wanders Creek - Thence West at 641 varas cross Wanders Creek Course N 20° E at 1774 a point 47 varas South of the South East Corner of Survey No 37 Block No 10. H. + T. C. R. R. Co. in Hardeman Co. Continuing West at fourteen miles and 67 varas a point 33 varas South of the North East Corner of Survey No 140 in Block H. W. + N. W. R. R. Said Block H at 1080 vars and 1379 vars cross and recross draw Course at 1400 vars Set Stone marked C L in mid and 4 pits in open Valley
