

Whereas at a former term, this Court entered an Order Commanding E. J. Flynt County Surveyor in conjunction with the County Surveyor of Wilbarger County to proceed at once to lay out Survey mark and establish the East County Line of Hardeman County and to make due report of their proceedings to this Court. And it appearing to the Court that said order has in all things been complied with and that said report has in due form been filed in this Court.

It is therefore ordered that said report be and it is hereby adopted and that the same shall hereafter mark the East line of said County and the same is here now spread upon the minutes of this Court. To wit-

To the Hon Commissioners Court of Hardeman County. E. J. Flynt Surveyor duly appointed by your Hon Court to lay off Survey mark and designate the East line of Hardeman County the same being part of the N. B. Line of Wilbarger County did in conjunction with J. A. Nabors, a Surveyor duly appointed by the Commissioners Court of Wilbarger County, for the same purpose did on the 18th February 5th day of March 1892. Survey and designate on the ground the East line of Hardeman County the same being a part of the N. B. line of Wilbarger County the field notes of which line is hereto attached together with a map thereof. E. J. Flynt Surveyor.

Field notes of a Survey ordered by the Commissioners Court of Hardeman and Wilbarger Counties for the establishment of the East line of Hardeman County and a part of the West line of Wilbarger County by E. J. Flynt duly appointed by the Commissioners Court of Hardeman County and J. A. Nabors duly appointed by the Commissioners Court of Wilbarger County both of which were legally qualified for that purpose.

Beginning at the S. W. Corner of Wilbarger County and N. W. Corner of Baylor County being marked with a Sand Stone set in the ground 3 x 3 in a valley of South Beaver Creek and marked $N \begin{matrix} E \\ K \end{matrix} / \begin{matrix} N \\ B \\ XXX \end{matrix} E$ on the South Side and H | W on North Side from which a Hackberry tree bears N. $25^{\circ} 45' E$. 138 varas another bears N. $21^{\circ} 30' E$. 131 varas (nisher one marked by a Red Sand Stone marked "A" on a natural Red Round Mound bears S. $57^{\circ} 45' W$. 112 varas distant. Thence N. 17 miles and 1143 varas to the Center of Pass River the same being the S. E. Corner of Hardeman County and the N. E. Corner of Howard County from which a C. W. marked X on North Side bears N. $56^{\circ} 34' W$. 379 varas and a 7th N. E. C. W. both prongs marked X on North Side bears N. $34^{\circ} 50' W$. 421 varas and a pile of Stone on Red Point bears N. $30^{\circ} 10' E$. and point of ridge bears S. $83^{\circ} 34' W$.
