Dr. Sir. Some of the surveys of which you requested the connections are not laid down on the maps of Harrison County; these I mapped, in the sketches, from the field notes.

There are two old maps of Harrison County, in my Office. When the one I usually use was so dilapidated or blotted that I could not possibly find a survey or its connections on it, I used the other - both, ~~being~~ though a little different, being delivered to me as maps of Harrison County.

I also send you a sketch from a portion of an old "Connection Map," showing the connections of the J. C. Walling and Holloways' surveys, which I sent you in pencil as soon as I discovered them. I now send them sketched with ink, as the others would not do in pencil. All these connections are as near correct as I can make them from the data I have.

Does the Law permit Scrips to be issued covering any number of acres from 1 to 160, including fractional parts of an acre, when such number of acres is all the vacant land to be found in that tract? Please answer soon. Yours very truly,
