This 9<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1841

This day and date we David Hill  
County Surveyor of the County of Panola  
and George D. McKinsey County Surveyor  
of the County of Harrison, meet according  
to instructions of the Genl. Land Commis-  
sioner (Thos. M. Ward) for the purpose  
of carrying into effect the said instruc-  
tions of running the Boundary Line  
between the Counties of Harrison & Panola.

The field notes of which line  
are as follows. to wit: Commencing  
at the South East corner of the dwelling  
house of Maj. Edward Smith's present  
residence. Thence Running due South  
3800 varas. to a corner stake from which  
point stands a pine 13 inches in diameter  
Bears North 15 West 15<sup>2</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas a post  
oak 18 inches in diameter Bears North  
43 West 15<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas Each marked I & II  
& a Post oak 12 inches in diameter Bears  
South 26 West 6<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas and a pine 10  
inches in diameter 8<sup>7</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas Each marked  
H. P.

Thence East 100 varas the  
Road from Edward Smith to Hancock  
Smith at 585 varas the West Fork of  
Lockage Bayou, at 5153 varas the  
West 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>10</sub> line of Sam Sharps Survey  
Being 1856 varas North of the South  
West Corner of the same, at 6531 varas  
the Middle Prong of Lockage Bayou  
and at 9680 varas the East Prong  
of Lockage Bayou 12230 varas. The  
Road leading from Fortson's store to  
Perdons Mill and at 13340 varas the  
United States and Texas Boundary  
line a stake from which a pine  
Bears South 28 East 5<sup>4</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas & a pine

Bears South 19 West 13 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas Both  
marks I & P and a fine Bear  
North 9 West 26 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas and a Red  
Oak Bear North 47 West Both  
marks I & P. This point is  
40 varas North of the 24 mile mound  
and 755 varas South of the North  
East corner of Theophilus Sawley's  
survey.

Thence returning to the point  
two miles South of the aforesaid  
Smiths. Running Thence from  
said point due West and at 1885  
ms the West Boundary line of Leonard  
Strows survey mark'd C. and 1840  
varas North of his said Strows South  
West corner at 2520 varas the road  
from Baley Anderson's to Holland Ander-  
son at 4885 varas the East Boundary  
line of Daniel Tuttle's Sen.<sup>r</sup> survey and 400 varas  
South of the S. E. corner of John Finley's  
survey and the North East corner of  
said Tuttle's League. at 4995 varas  
Tuttle's Creek at 8950 varas the road  
leading from Grand Bluffs to Shreve-  
port at 9970 varas the West Boundary  
line of said Daniel Tuttle's survey is  
425 varas. South of his North West corner  
at 11000 ms. Caney Creek at 11660 ms. the  
Caddo Creek at 17750 ms. the West  
Boundary line of John Wray's survey  
being 185 ms. North his S. West corner  
of land 18500 varas the Eight mile  
Creek at 23850 varas the Sabine  
River a State from which a  
Sassafras Bear North 40 E. 13 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas
