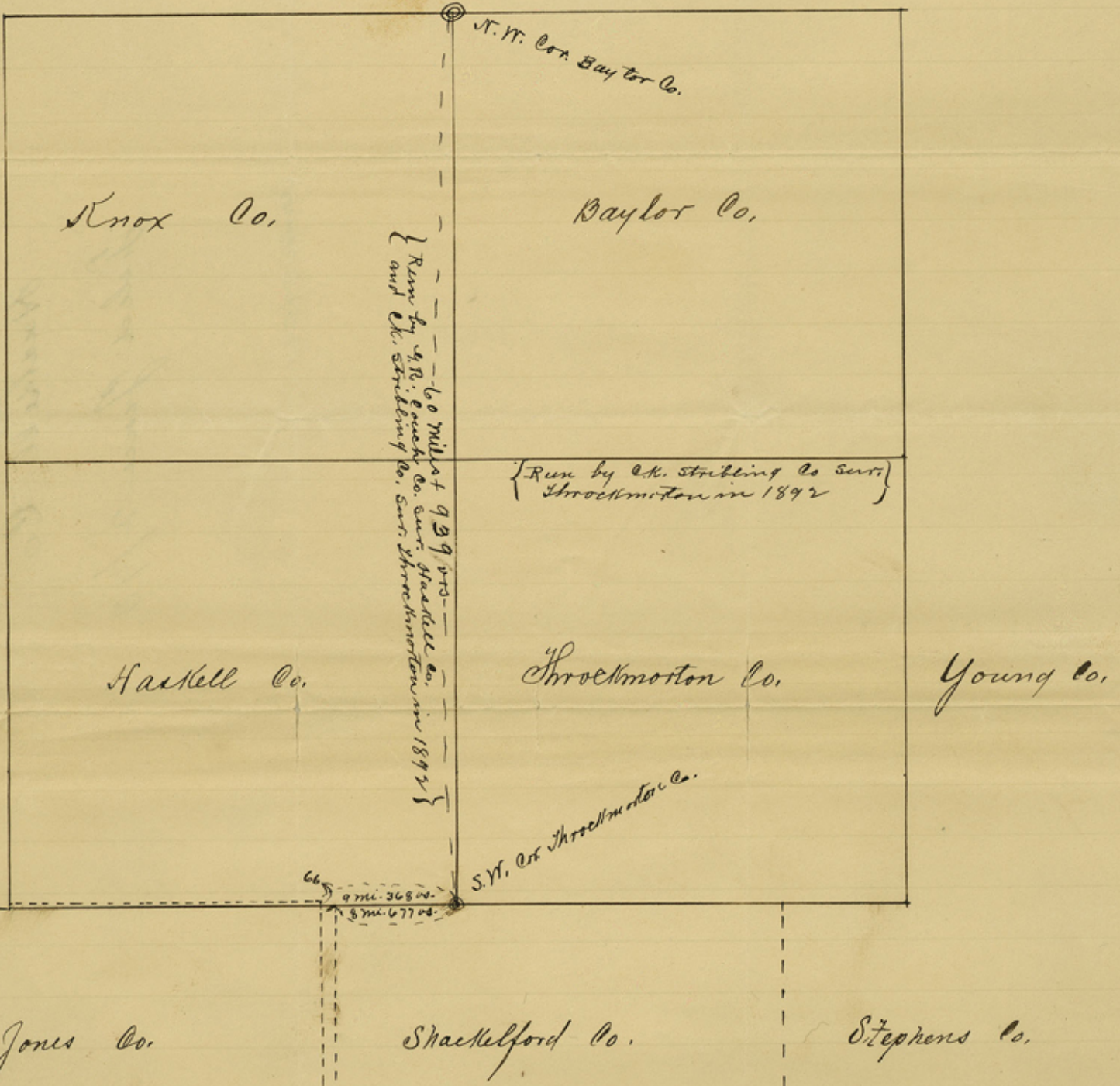
Dear Sir: In running the south line of Haskell County in 1890 I began at the S.W. corner of Throckmorton County as established by the County Surveyors of Shackelford and Throckmorton Counties. Thence I ran west at 8 miles and 677 vrs I found the N.W. Cor. of Shackelford Co. established by W. A. Eckhart Sur. of Shackelford Co. At 9 miles 368 vrs (west from S.W. Cor. Throckmorton Co.) we are 66 vrs south of N.E. corner of Jones County as established by Martin Dural leaving 1591 vrs space between Shackelford County and Jones County. On our run from S.W. corner of Throckmorton County to N.W. Cor. of Baylor as established by County Surveyors of Baylor & Wilbarger Counties we found it to be 60 miles and 939 vrs and we established the N.E. Cor. of Haskell & N.W. Cor. of Throckmorton at a point dividing that excess which makes Haskell's East and Throckmorton's West lines 30 miles and 469 vrs long, and West line of Baylor Co. same length. Yours truly G. R.
