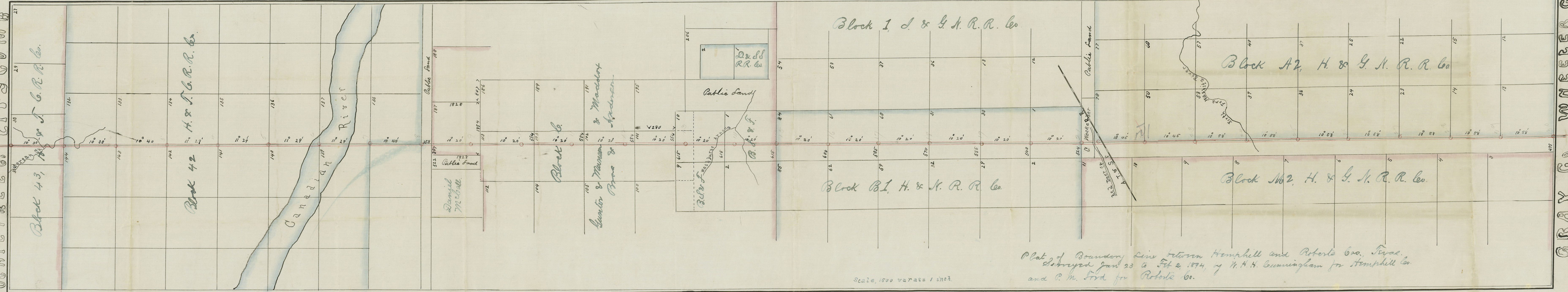

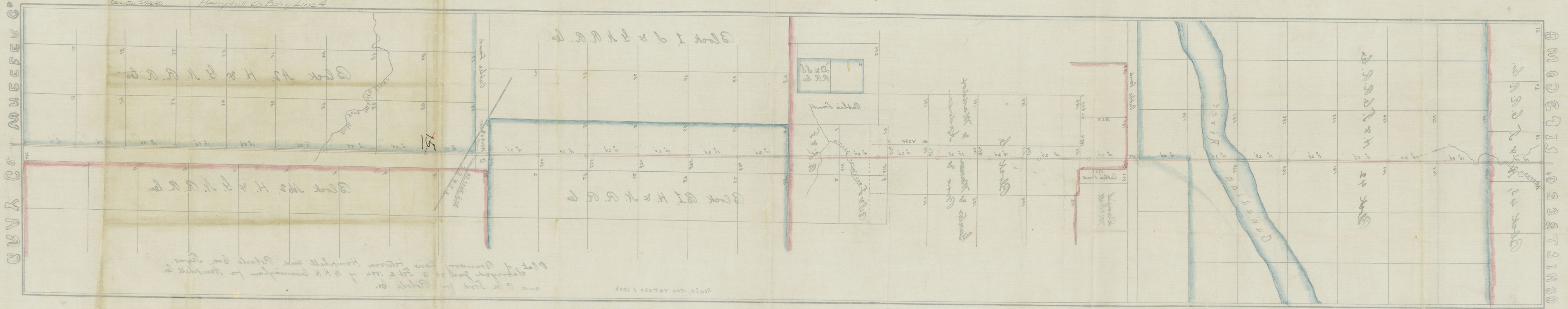
Plat of Boundary line between Homphill and Roberts Cos., Texas.

5 Beginning at an Iron Pipe in a rock mound
 6 2 ft high, in North line of Survey 30, Block 43,
 7 H. & T. C. R. R. lands, said Pipe $5' \times 1\frac{1}{2}"$, and set
 8 for S. W. corner of Lipscomb Sec, the N. W. corner
 9 of Hemphill Sec, the S. E. corner of Ochiltree
 10 Sec, and the N. E. corner of Roberts Sec, thence
 11 South, variation $10^{\circ} 30'$, at 950 varas cross draw, at
 12 1120 varas, 1300 varas, and 1580 varas cross West
 13 prong of Morgan Creek; at 1958 varas the N. W.
 14 corner of Survey 132, Block 42, H. & T. C. R. R. Sec.
 15 land. Set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2}' \times 1\frac{1}{4}"$ in original mound
 16 Pipe marked "1 M H R".

 18 Second Mile.

19 Thence South, variation $10^{\circ} 30'$, at 525 and 640
 20 varas cross West prong of Morgan Creek, at 720
 21 varas draw; at 1918 varas the N. W. corner of
 22 Survey 133 and N. E. of 143, Block 42, H. & T. C. R.
 23 R. lands. Set Iron Pipe marked "2 M H R" in
 24 original mound.

 26 Third Mile.

27 Thence South, variation $10^{\circ} 40'$, at 420, 1050 and
 28 1560 varas cross draws; at 1881 varas the N. W.
 29 corner of Survey 134 and N. E. of 142, Block 42
 30 aforesaid. Set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2}' \times 1\frac{1}{4}"$ marked "3 M
 31 H R" in original mound.

Fourth Mile.

Thence South, variation $11^{\circ} 29'$, 1900 varas to N.W. corner of Survey 135 and N.E. of 141, Block 42 aforesaid. Set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{4}$ marked "4M H.R."

Fifth Mile.

Thence South, variation $11^{\circ} 29'$, at 1900 varas the N.W. corner of Survey 136 and N.E. of 140, Block 42 aforesaid. Set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{4}$ marked "5M H.R."

Sixth Mile.

Thence South, variation $11^{\circ} 29'$, at 1565 varas N. bank Canadian River, at 1900 varas N.W. corner of Survey 137 and N.E. of 139, Block 42 aforesaid in bed of Canadian River.

Seventh Mile.

Thence South, variation $11^{\circ} 29'$, at 1100 varas S. bank Canadian River; at 1830 varas the S.W. of Survey 138 and S.E. of 139, Block 42 aforesaid. Original Post marked "139". Set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{4}$ marked "7M H.R." in original mound.

Note. From this corner the old S.W. corner of Survey 137 is West 976 varas and South. 358 varas, the original witness trees still standing.

Eighth Mile.

Thence South, variation $10^{\circ} 49'$, at 45 varas the Canadian and Parnell Road, at 1906 varas a stone mound, the S.W. corner of Survey 138, Block 42 aforesaid. Set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{4}$ marked "8M H.R." in original mound.

Ninth Mile.

Thence South, variation $10^{\circ} 20'$, at 358 varas cross North line of Survey 187, Block C, of Gunter & Munson & Madox Broe & Anderson's Survey, at a point 307 varas East of S.W. corner; at 1900 varas set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{4}$ marked "9 M H R", in mound and 4 pits.

Tenth Mile

Thence South, variation $10^{\circ} 20'$, at 286 varas cross South line of Survey 187, Block C. aforesaid, at 1900 varas set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{4}$ marked "10 M H R" in mound of stone.

Eleventh Mile.

Thence South, variation $10^{\circ} 20'$, at 286 varas South line of Survey 113, Block C aforesaid, at a point 554 varas West of S.E. corner; at 1900 varas set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{4}$ marked "11 M H R" in bottom of deep, rocky draw; from pipe a Hackberry 4 inches diameter base South $6\frac{1}{2}$ varas; a cedar stump 14 inches diameter and about 6 ft high, base $S 26^{\circ} 25' W. 34\frac{1}{2}$ varas; bearings marked X

Twelfth Mile.

Thence South, variation $10^{\circ} 20'$, at 286 varas cross South line of Survey 103, Block C aforesaid, at a point 554 varas West of S.E. corner, at 1900 varas set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{4}$ marked "12 M H R" in mound and 4 pits.

Thence South, variation $10^{\circ} 20'$, at 286 varas cross South line of Survey 102, Block C aforesaid at a point 554 varas West of S. E. corner; at 900 varas cross Isaac Bro's. pasture fence, at 1110 varas cross draw; at 1566 varas cross North line of Survey 10 of Preaty, Seal & Forwood's Surveys at a point 615 varas East of N. W. corner; at 1900 varas set Iron Pipe $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{4}$ marked "13 M H R" in mound and 4 pits

Fourteenth Mile

Thence South, variation $10^{\circ} 20'$, at 1390 varas pass Isaac Bro's house about 125 varas East of line; at 1425 varas cross North prong of Washburne Arroyo; at 1566 varas cross South line of Survey 10 of Preaty, Seal & Forwood's Surveys at a point 615 varas East of N. W. corner; at 1900 varas set Iron pipe $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{4}$ marked "14 M H R" in mound and 4 pits.

Fifteenth Mile

Thence South, variation $10^{\circ} 20'$, at 640 varas cross South prong of Washburne Arroyo; at 1566 varas cross North line of Survey 84, Block B1, H. & G. N. R. R. land, at a point 615 varas East of N. W. corner; set Iron pipe marked "H R"; at 1900 varas End of fifteenth mile.
