In pursuance of an order of the
Hon County Court of Henderson County issued
on the day of A.D. 1890. and of Anderson
County issued on the 12th day of May 1890,
directing J. T. Meredith on the part of Hen-
derson County — Vaunoy as a Commis-
sioner of Anderson County to see to the
beginning of the line — J. T. Meredith
beg leaf to report that I was not met by
any one, and began and run the line as ordered
by the Court at the S. W. corner of Henderson
it being the N. W. cor of Anderson County,
I designated the old corner by the two
witness trees which was two ash trees, one 20
in dia mhd A C, bxs 8.89° E. 7½ vrs, and
another 36 in dia bxs 8.41° E. 10½ vrs (the corner
tree was gone) from which point I began on a
variation of 81° 20' (The original calls for 80° 50')
Thence N. 81° 20' E. 1900^{8/10} vrs a mound, with a cup
16 in E. 6 vrs mhd A X H, 1st mound —
Thence N. 81° 20' E. 1900^{8/10} vrs 2nd mound, with an

Thompson's field near the edge of Trinity River

Thence N. $81^{\circ} 20'$ E. 1900 $\frac{9}{10}$ was 10th mound, wit a Bj. 12 in S. 60. N. 7 was mkd A=10. Do N. 55. N. 12 was mkd H=10. Thence N. $81^{\circ} 20'$ E. 1900 $\frac{9}{10}$ was 11th mound, wit a Bj. 10 in N. 17. N. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ was mkd H=11. Do 12 in dia S. 50° E. 5 was mkd A=11. Thence N. $81^{\circ} 20'$ E. at 640 was Coon Creek at 1900 $\frac{9}{10}$ was 13th mound wit a Hkry 12 in bxs S. 58° N. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ was mkd A=12.

in oed road, wit a Bj. 18 in N. 10° W. 10 vrs mzd H⁼18. Thence N. 81° 20' E. with oed Co. road 1900^{8/10} vrs 19th mound, wit Bj. 18 in N. 35° W 5 vrs. a P.OK N. 25 E. 7 vrs mzd H⁼19.

Thence N. 81° 20' E. with said road at 1900^{8/10} vrs 20th mound, wit a Hwy 16 in N. 69° E. 7^{1/2} vrs mzd H 20. Thence N. 81° 20' E. 1900^{8/10} vrs 21st mound, wit Bj. 18 in bns S. 1^{1/2} vrs mzd A⁼21. Thence N. 81° 20' E. 1900^{8/10} vrs 22nd mound. Bj. 10 in S. 40. E. 3 vrs mzd A⁼22.

Thence N. 81° 20' E. at 1900^{8/10} vrs 23rd mound wit Bj. 8 in N. 70. E. 10 vrs mzd H⁼23.

Thence N. 81° 20' E. 1900^{8/10} vrs 24th mound wit a Hwy 12 in S. 69° W. 11 vrs mzd H, a S.J. 12 in S. 20 E. 11 vrs mzd A⁼24. Thence N. 81° 20' E. 1900^{8/10} vrs 25th mound in Thomas Gains field about 90 vrs West of his house. Thence N. 81° 20' E. 1900^{8/10} vrs the 26th mound, wit a P.OK 18 in N. 50 E. 2^{1/2} vrs mzd H⁼26. Thence N. 81° 20' E. at 1760 vrs Newcastle & Palestine road, at 1900^{8/10} vrs 27th mound wit a Pine 12 in bns S 35 E. 15 vrs. Thence N. 81^t 20' E. at 1800 was the 3d cor of the Ferguson League and the cor of Anderson & Henderson Counties —
