All this the 20th day of March
1882 came on for consideration the
report of the survey of the division
line between the Counties of Hill and
McLennan made by W H Vaughan
Surveyor of Hill County and J S Suratt
Surveyor for McLennan County in
pursuance of a former order of this
Court. Said report after due consider-
ation of the Court is approved and
it is ordered that the same together
with the plat and field notes accom-
panying be placed of record upon the
minutes of this Court and that
the Clerk of this Court furnish
the Commissioner of the General
Land office of the State of Texas with
a certified copy of the same. Said
report is as follows

To the County Court of Hill County Texas
I beg leave to submit to your
honorable Court the following as a
report of a survey made under
orders issued out this on the
day of 1882 appointing, and
acting in concert with a like special surveyor,
designing me as special surveyor,
appointed by the County Court of McLennan
County to locate and define the
boundary line between the Counties
of Hill and McLennan of of said
State.

In pursuance of an in obedience to
instruction contained in aforesaid order
at 12 m on February 1st 1882 thre being
present WM Vaughan assisted by
C Teal surveyors appointed to represent
Kee County and J R Durath assisted by SM
Jawinson Surveyors appointed to represent
such McLennan County we entered upon
the work aforesaid taking the ^{center of the} public
square in the city of Waco for our star-
ting point from which to measure a base
line up the Brazos river the distance of
15 miles as per directions in aforesaid
order from this point and by a careful
Survey & Measurement of said dis-
tance of both from said starting
point we ascertained that a point at 300 ft
from our starting point 15 miles dis-
tant would be about 680 rods below the
mouth or upper line of the Llano River
Leagor survey and 187 1/2 rods below
the point on the Brazos river selected
by Teal and Jawinson Surveyors
acting under order issued out of the
Commissioners Court during the year
1880 for the beginning point of the line
selected and marked out by them at that
time We would here state that running
from Waco North Westerly with the
general course of the river would not
would not reach as far up the river
by a hundred or more rods as the


This will certify that, from partial measurements and from records of distances, the East boundary line of McLennan County, Texas, is about 27 miles long.



