County. The Court received the ~~lines~~ Survey and  
refused the Map. ~~Now~~ the ground that  
the Map & Survey was incorrect. Mr. Hiram  
McMillon asked for further time which  
was granted upon his proposition to pro-  
ceed his work and give Lamar County sur. 30  
Miles North & South - by commencing at the  
Mouth of Boisdearc on Red River & Run  
South 30 Miles and established for the N. W. C.  
of Hopkins the S. W. Corner of Lamar County for in-  
begining point of Hopkins County, this he failed to  
do - his bond is forfeited and his work is held  
for naught, the Survey was received by the Court  
at former Court, ~~that~~ and only present and presiding  
3 County Commissioners - the map was presented  
at a term of the Court 3 Months after the Survey  
was presented. - This Certificate is given the Sur-  
veyor of this County to assist him in the Genl Land  
Office, as we claim & hold to our old County  
Lines - To Certify which I hereunto sign my  
name and affix the Seal of the County  
on this 13 day of June 1863
