Dear Sir:

This acknowledges receipt of yours of the 2d inst. in which you enclosed plat and field notes of the County line between Mitchell and Howard Counties.

I am returning these papers under separate cover for reason that the field notes are not signed and certified to by you as Surveyor, nor is there anything to show that this work was done under the direction or orders of the County Courts of these two counties.

In returning these papers to this office, same should be accompanied with certified copies of the orders of the court, appointing you as surveyor to make the survey. Also copies of the orders of said courts approving your survey. The field notes also should show book and page where they are recorded in the two counties.

You attention is called to the fact that according to the field notes of the South West corner of Scurry County and the North West corner of Mitchell County as established by H. W. Stoneham and Hugh Goodwin in 1907. It does not appear identical or common with the North East corner of Howard and the South East Corner of Borden as established by W. S. McCleng and T. H. Seay in 1908. The line as run by you should tie into these corners in such manner as to show their relative position and whether or not the corner as fixed by you is at either of the above mentioned corners. Your field notes also should show whether or not the South West corner of Mitchell County and the South East corner of Howard County is the same corner as that heretofore established by Stoneham and Goodwin in 1907.

In this connection you will note that it would seem that each county affected should appoint a surveyor to make a joint survey of the county boundries, and your report to this office should show such fact and reason, if any, for noncooperation in this work. See Art. 1588 as above referred to.

IN: RE: Mitchell - Howard County line Mitchell and Howard Counties, have employed Mr. Frank Lupton of this city to make the surveys as required by your office to establish the line between the two Counties.

The Fuller line as surveyed in 1922 is the agreed line between the Courts of the two counties. The abstract books of the two counties correspond to the Fuller line.

Your objection to the Fuller line is that the surveys do not properly tie into the line. That is the work we have employed Mr. Lupton to do ...

When he satisfies your department on the line we will be satisfied.

Mr. Lupton tells me that you want too know his authority for the work he has done in this connection. If you regire orders of the two courts, we can furnish them, if not this letter will suffice.

We want to get the line definately settled in the land office, as stated above the counties have agreed to the line.
